Highlights from the Sessional Sub-Committee Meeting January 2019

Sessional/VTS Conference 15th May 2019

The group went through the agenda and proposed conference pack. It was agreed that none of the agenda items were suitable for breakouts. It was agreed that the agenda should be included with the flyer on the LMC website as more people would be likely to be attracted to the conference after seeing the agenda. It was agreed not to supply paper handouts of the talks on the day but to put them on the LMC website after the event and to check whether we can email out to attendees.

It was suggested that it would be good to have some information about where you can find jobs as a GP e.g. LMC website, Meddoc, Lantum etc. It was agreed we could create a stand for the conference. Caroline Rickard agreed to collate the information and others volunteered to help with the stand at the conference.

Future of First 5/Next Gen

Alicia Watts has set up the First 5 group in East Kent with one-year funding from the CCGs. They are hopeful that it can continue next year but funding is unsure at present. There are currently 20 members of the group. They would like to see this rolled out across the county. AW reported very good feedback. Ginika Lazz-Onyenobi added that she had found it really useful as
