VARM and Hoarding Grant

2018 saw a revision of the VARM process. This has resulted in a revised policy and information booklet for adults at risk, the employment of a VARM co-ordinator, and consolidation of the hoarding grant. There can be little doubt that the VARM has led to successful outcomes for adults. Many referrals involving self-neglect and, in particular hoarding, have had successful interventions

and outcomes. The number of VARM meetings being held across the County has increased. A recent VARM case file audit provided further evidence of effective inter-agency working and positive results for individuals. These cases are often complex and high risk.

Feedback from Safeguarding Adult Reviews

A learning brief for practitioners has been produced following SAR17A but cannot currently be shared until a decision has been made by HMC whether to hold an inquest.

Feedback from Domestic Homicide Reviews

A further DHR was commissioned recently following a death in Chesterfield, GP surgery are assisting with the drafting of the chronology and individual management review (IMR) for both victim and perpetrator.

Mental Capacity Act/Deprivation of Liberty update

Awaiting the new Code of Practice for the new liberty protection safeguards now expected late 2019.

Derby/Derbyshire Safeguarding Adult Board

Each of the DSAB's supporting Sub Committee's:- Performance Improvement Sub Group, MCA & DoLs, Learning and Development, Customer Inclusion and Making Safeguarding Personal have now developed action plans linked to key objectives within the DSAB's 3 year strategic plan. The key objectives of the strategy are quality assurance, prevention and making safeguarding personal.

Safeguarding Assurance

Varieties of models are being used across the NHS to evaluate provider performance in relation to adult safeguarding and associated topics. The safeguarding adult assurance framework (SAAF), the joint safeguarding assurance framework for Primary Care (JSAF) and the joint independent provider safeguarding assurance framework document, as well as individual visits and the monitoring of activity are all used to monitor and assess performance.

The CCG is hosting a multi-agency emergency planning event following the Panorama, Whorlton Hall undercover exposé into abusive criminal behaviour perpetrated by staff members. The purpose of the event is to develop a protocol to manage interventions in the event of a care setting closure
