# The Aims of Adult Services

- Early intervention can provide information and advise including contingency planning for the carer and the client keeping them independent in the community for longer
- We work with partner agencies for example OPAL, trading standards, police, fire service, mail preference services, housing and many more.

# Early Intervention

- By being involved early we can prevent loss of independence as long as possible.
- Support at diagnosis stage working with HCC Dementia Advisers to explore options.
- Initially we can provide information and advise.
- Carer support e.g. Princess Royal Trust, Take a Break, Respite

# How we Can Help

- Liaison with GPs, geriatricians, older persons mental health services
- Mental capacity assessments and best interest decisions
- Developing skills/ using tools to prompt memory referrals to memory clinics
- Extra care housing as an option for the future

# Future Planning

- Milestone planning to allow people to keep control of their lives
- Future planning – Wills, Lasting Power of Attorney
- Group support – circles of support, memory books, reminiscence support
- Providing practical support such as meals on wheels and Argenti

# Practical Support

- We can provide an assessment of needs to identify and provide
- service for carers
- safeguarding when required
- support with personal care including REACT
- day care to avoid social isolation or to provide carer respite
- Occupational Therapy and Sensory assessments
- Residential or nursing care.
