

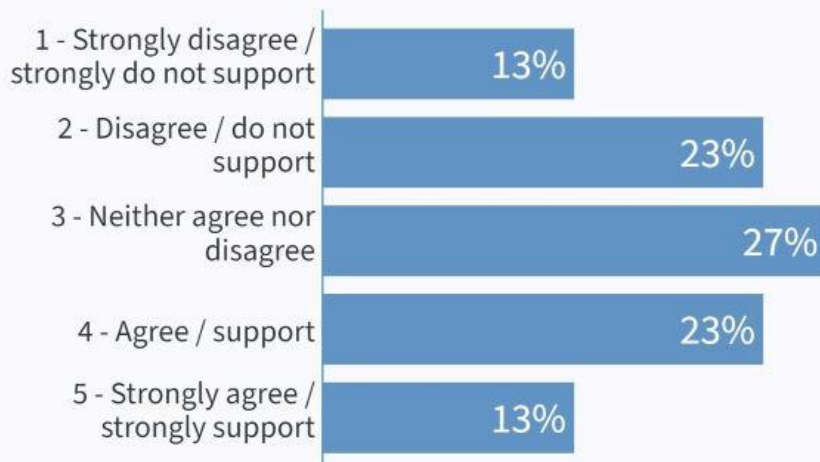
LMC Update November 8th 2021

Winter Access Fund Announcement

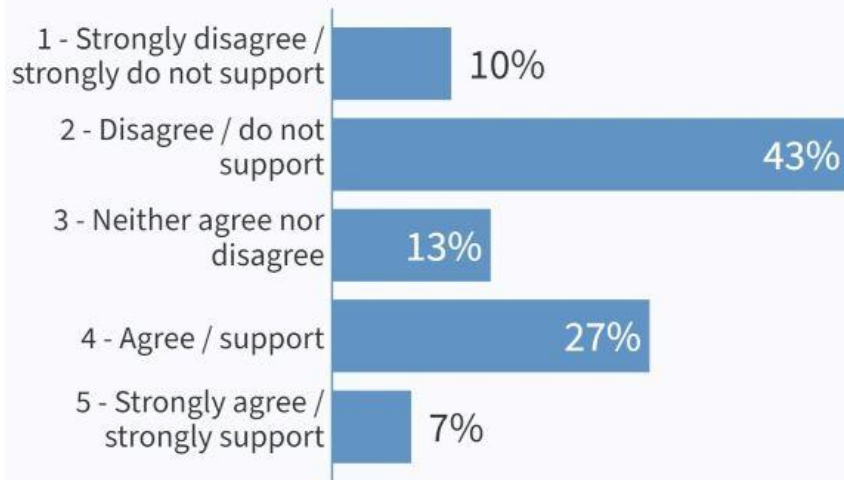
On 4th November 2021 we held an online event to give our constituents the opportunity to have their say on the recently announced plans for [a £250million Winter Access Fund](#) and the subsequent [proposals from the BMA for GPs to take immediate action](#) to convince NHSEI and Government of the need to withdraw their plan and work with the BMA on a genuine support package for practices.

At the meeting we gave attendees the opportunity to vote on the various suggested actions set out in the BMA proposals. The results are set out below:

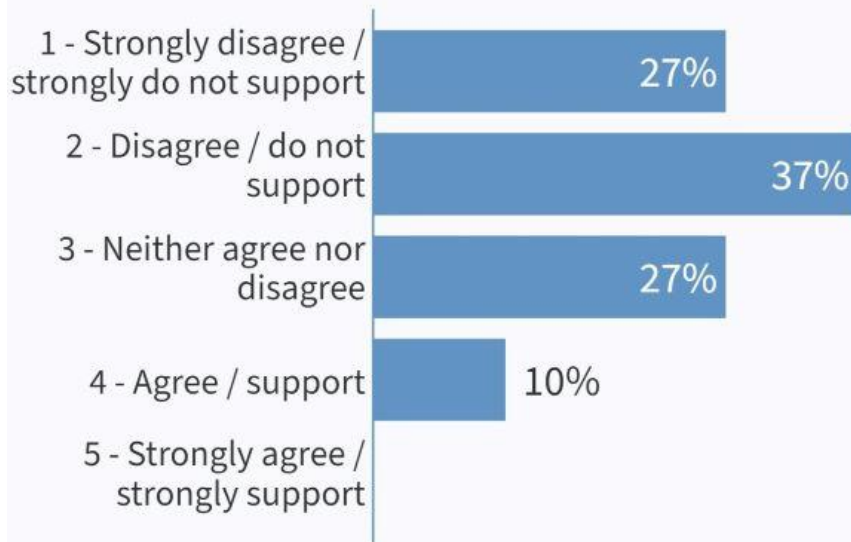
Rejecting the NHSE winter access plan published on 14th October 2021



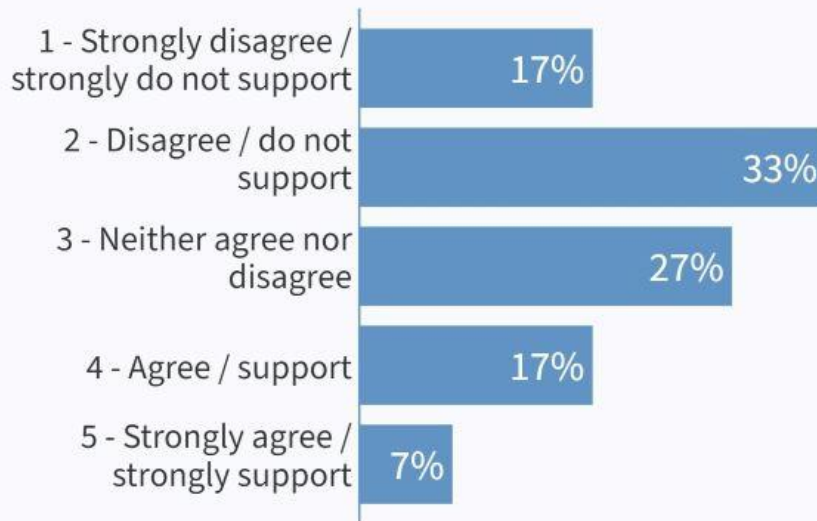
Asking the LMC to disengage from any participation in implementing the NHSE plan



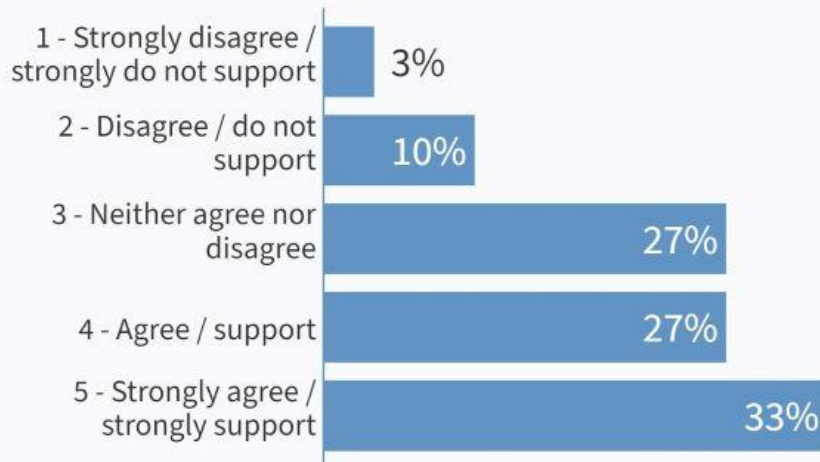
Pausing ARRS recruitment



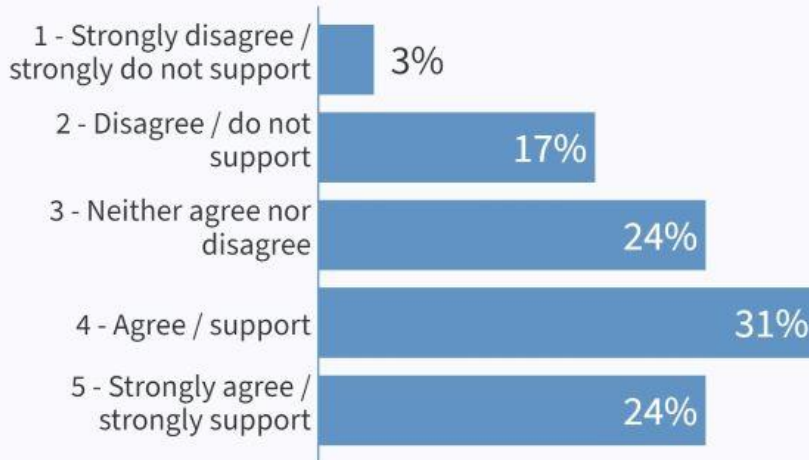
Disengaging from the demands of the PCN DES



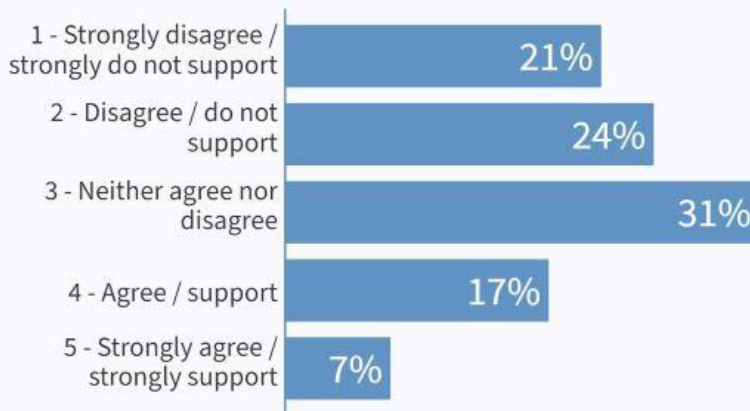
Advocating refusal to engage/comply with pay transparency requirements



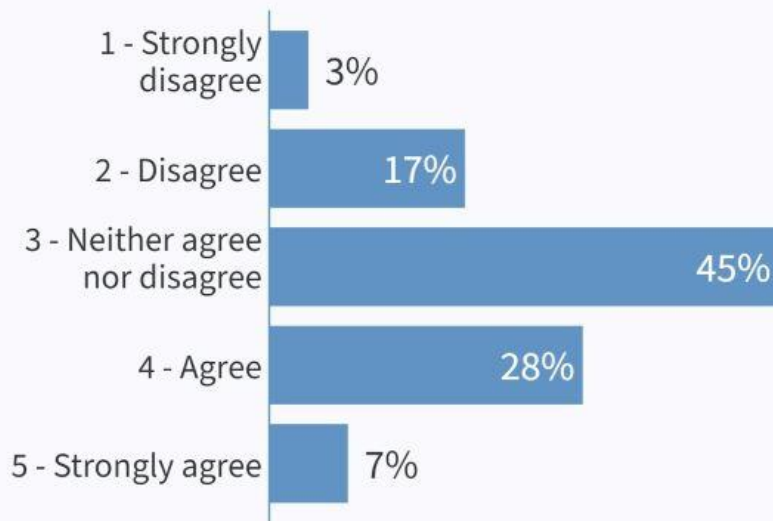
Advocating refusal to engage/comply with COVID-19 medical exemption requirements
