

- **Certificates of Attendance**

Using Zoom for our virtual training

How this works:

- We ask you to book as normal via our SGPET website.

PLEASE REMEMBER THE EMAIL YOU GIVE WHEN YOU BOOK WILL BE THE ADDRESS ALL INFORMATION FOR THIS EVENT WILL BE SENT TO.

- Initially an automated email will be sent to you confirming your booking
- Three days before the actual training a link will be emailed to you asking you to register for the Zoom session. *(Please check your spam/junk folders if you think you've not received the link email)*
- Please ensure you register before the time of the meeting *(Registering is vital for us to know exactly who joins, if you don't complete we will have no record of your attendance)*
- After registering, you will receive an email with the link to join the training
- When joining, always remember to click join with video and join with audio
- You will be able to mute yourselves once joined, or turn on/off your video
- We do ask you to keep the video on, as it is very hard for the speakers if they cannot see attendees
- The basic difference between Zoom Webinars and Zoom Meetings.
 - A webinar is where only the speakers are visible; you join as normal but just watch the presentation/s there is a Q&A function, but other than that it is not interactive.
 - A meeting is a more interactive session where attendees are visible and also able to ask questions via their audio.
