### **Discussions with Locala**

YORLMC officers have had a series of meetings with representatives of Locala, alongside GPs and practice managers from BAWC and a senior officer from Bradford Metropolitan District Council (the commissioners of the sexual health service).

These meetings have been an opportunity to discuss sexual health services and raise concerns with Locala representatives that funding for these services must be sufficient to make the service sustainable for practices.

It has also been raised with Locala that SH:24, a free online sexual health service, which launched in the Bradford area in 1 June, will be simply unsuitable for many of the patients in the Bradford.

YORLMC will continue to raise concerns with Locala: please inform the YORLMC Corporate Affairs Team if you encounter any problems with the new service.

## Reporting method for NHS Standard Contract breaches – City & Districts

YORLMC officers have raised concerns with Bradford City & Districts about the lengthy process needed to report NHS Standard Contract breaches via the RAP button.

Following this the CCGs have advised that **prescribing-related** contract breaches can now be reported to the CCGs via email on <a href="mailto:Bradford.hcai@nhs.net">Bradford.hcai@nhs.net</a>. Patient identifiable information can be included on emails sent to this address. Please note that this is for use by Bradford City and Bradford Districts practices only and emails must be sent from the practice nhs.net email rather than an individual GP's email.

Discussions are continuing between YORLMC and the CCGs about setting up email reporting systems for other contract breaches, in addition to prescribing.
