

GUIDE TO SOUTH DEVON AND TORBAY CCG COMMISSIONED SERVICES 2018/19

The table below details or summarises CCG Commissioned Services from General Practice by South Devon and Torbay CCG. Practices are invited to provide all services contained in the contract which the practice is eligible to provide.

All CCG Commissioned Services are provided and funded in addition to the “Essential” and “Additional” services provided by GMS practices and to the services specified in PMS practices agreements.

Every effort is made to ensure that the information within this document is correct, but it does not alter the information set out in service specifications or correspondence sent to practices regarding these CCG Commissioned services and the fees payable.

The fees for all CCG Commissioned Services have been increased by 1% (this increase will take effect from 1st April 2018 and payments will be backdated).

The payment process in 2018/19 is the same as 2017/18 arrangements. For the 2018/19 contract practices will be asked to submit two claim forms per year (apart from the Injectable Diabetic Therapy Initiation service which they will be required to submit three claim forms per year).

An electronic claim form will be emailed to you for completion based on the following schedule

- April 2018 to September 2018 (claim form will be sent in October 2018)
- October 2018 to February 2019 (claim form will be sent in March 2019)
- March 2019 (In Injectable Diabetic Therapy Initiation only) (claim form will be sent out in April 2019)
