#### **SWAFFHAM RUFC SEEKING A HEAD COACH**

Swaffham RUFC is seeking a Head coach for their senior side in the 2018-2019 season when the 1<sup>st</sup> XV will be playing in Eastern Counties Div. 2 North.

Candidates should preferably have a current RFU coaching qualification (though not essential) but would be expected to achieve at least Level 2, and complete CPD courses, in order to maintain this qualification during their time in post. All courses will be funded by the club and are seen as essential for the candidate's development. Candidates should also possess a passion for developing people and players.

There will be no direct financial payments for their services but the Club will endeavour to cover any reasonable costs incurred, and provide necessary kit to perform the role. Details of this arrangement will be confirmed at interview.

The successful applicant will be asked to assist the current Coach ideally for the last month of 2017/18 season to allow them to familiarise themselves with the playing level, Club operation, and also to develop plans for the following season.

The applicant will be expected to plan and run training, and pre-season sessions, at least once a week, and be present at all League and Cup games. The method of Team selection is yet to be decided but they will have to work closely with the Captain, to help the development of all players within the Club.

Swaffham has a talented pool of players at all ages with a very good Minis section and a growing Youth squad. We have the use of excellent club facilities together with a floodlit training area.

Applications from all suitably qualified persons regardless of their race, sex, disability, religion/belief, sexual orientation or age will be considered and the successful candidate will work with all Senior players as well as the Assistant Coach.
