Cricket East County Age Group Lead Coach – Advert



Overview

The role of the Cricket East Player County Age Group Lead Coach is to lead the decision making and management of Age Group team/s in line with Cricket East's Talent Development Framework and Cricket East Coaches and Managers Code of Conduct

The coach of Cricket East representative age groups will have the following responsibilities:

- Plan and deliver coaching sessions involving Assistant Coach/es where possible.
- Support the Team Manager
- Liaise with the Cricket East Performance Team/Office to keep them up to date on player attendance
- To adhere to relevant codes of conduct, including Safeguarding, equality etc.
- To carry out tasks as required to ensure compliance with legislation.

Pre Match Day Preparation

- Know the rules of the competition (ECB or Friendly)
- Prepare and deliver warm up
- Team selection in conjunction with manager
- Ensure you have the relevant equipment, including match and practise balls

Match Day

- Coach and Manager arrive before players. Prior to agreed meet time
- Meet and greet the opposition Coach and Manager as well as Umpires and Groundsman
- Check facilities for health and safety
- Set up and deliver warm ups and player preparation
- Lead team talks and briefing with players
- Work with and support the players on the day
- Liaise with the captain
- Inform players of batting order

Post game roles

- Lead team reflections and de briefs with assistance of Manager
- Make sure all players leave with a responsible adult or parent before leaving yourself

Rained off or cancelled fixtures

• Assist Manager with communication as early as possible with opposition/grounds man.

• In the event of a rained off or cancelled fixtures ensure that opposition, parents, officials and venue are advised as soon as possible.

End of Year tasks

- Assist manager with written end of season squad review in format requested by Performance Lead.
- Assist manager with organising names of winners for end of season trophies
- Player assessment documents to be passed on to Performance Lead

Attire

• Coaching staff must wear official Beds/Hunts training kit, a voucher will be available to contribute towards this.

Requirements

- UKCC Level 2 Coach or above
- Up to date First Aid, Safeguarding & Protecting Children certificates
- Have a valid ECB DBS
- ECBCA membership
- Valid UK Driving Licence
