Vacancy for a Full Time Club Development Officer To commence immediately

Following a successful year at RI our current Club Development Officer has been appointed to a role within the RFU and to replace him we are looking for a young enthusiastic qualified sportsperson with outstanding communication and organisational skills to lead recruitment, training and development of our junior section. The position requires full time commitment including weekends and some evenings and the appointed candidate will need to deliver successful outcomes to an agreed program.

Role: To promote the game of rugby union in the name of York RI Rugby Club working closely with RFU Development team. To liaise with local schools and colleges in the development of rugby with the objective of channelling the enthusiasm of young players into becoming RI players, with their parents commitment also. To develop junior teams at the club and to design and implement a network of team coaches from parents, current and former players. To play a lead role in delivery of the All Schools Programme. To assist club coaches with development of senior mens and womens sides and individual players. To identify, recommend and secure funding opportunities for all aspects of the club including facilities, coaching and player improvement.
