#### **Bucks County U15 Girls Team.**

#### **Purpose:**

To work with the team manager and assistant coaches to ensure that the playing squad are fully prepared for its pre-planned County fixtures. Acting as an influential figure in players' lives, you will be expected to set an example to both players and their parents/carers etc.

This is an exciting and extremely rewarding opportunity to develop both the players and yourself within representative rugby and influencing player performance and matchday outcome. The U15 girls season runs between April 10<sup>th</sup> and May 29<sup>th</sup> 2022, with trials day, 3 training sessions and 3 match days.

#### **Key aspects of the role**

- 1. Lead training sessions.** Plan, deliver and review safe, engaging and effective training sessions; role model rugby's values, and codes of conduct while developing individuals' skill, confidence and fitness
- 2. Adopt a Player centered approach.** Have a clear Coaching and Playing philosophy aligned to the wants and needs of every player
- 3. Team selection.** Lead on matchday team selections, working with assistant coaches. Ensuring that between the Age Grade management team, that all the squad players are provided with clear feedback, both post-match and at the conclusion of the program. Ensuring that all AG regulations regarding the players are, were needed, are communicated (via team manager) and complied with.

**General.** To work with the team manager, to ensure that fairness, transparency, diversity and player welfare are at the heart of what we do. Ensure that **ALL** players enjoy a positive and rewarding "County" experience. Help to develop your assistant coaches throughout the short window of opportunity and provide appropriate feedback. Have a good understanding of player development pathways both locally and nationally, have a knowledge of club and school rugby within Bucks and be aware of the processes around the girls Centers of Excellence and maintain effective communication with their staff.

#### **Is this role for you?**

If you are enthusiastic, hold an appropriate RFU Coaching Award, are knowledgeable about the game and committed to fair play, this could be the role for you. You will need to be confident, approachable

and good with people. You will hold a role that is highly respected in the rugby community and will become an inspiration to a group of young people looking to develop their sporting life.
