To make the lists below for best batting average, there was a requirement to have batted at least five times in Division 1, four in Divisions 2 and 3 and three in Division 4.

To make the lists below for best bowling average, economy rate and strike rate, there was a requirement to have bowled at least 30 overs in Division 1, 25 overs in Division 2, 15 in Division 3 and 10 in Division 4.

Eligibility for the Teams of the Year was also subject to these requirements.

The Teams of the Year have been selected according to a formula:

- The player ranked top for batting average scored one point and the second ranked batter scored two, and so on, with a similar system used for total runs. These points scores were then added and the batters with the lowest total points scores across both total runs and averages were selected for the team. For example, Ellie Mason scored two points as the highest ranked batter in Division One on both measures
- Four different bowling criteria were used: total wickets, average, economy rate and strike rate. In Division One, Gemma Rose was ranked equal top for total wickets, first for both strike rate and average and 15th for economy rate, so she scored a total of 18 points.
- The selected wicketkeeper is the player with the most dismissals in this area
- Players shown as all-rounders are those who qualified for these divisional teams as both batters and bowlers

Ellie Mason smashed the previous record season aggregate of 583 that was held by Ali Cutler, indeed Roshini Prince-Navaratnam's total would have seen her top this list in almost any other year. The top three were well ahead of their rivals, with Jenny Dunn taking fourth spot despite only batting on three occasions, indeed on every occasion she batted, she shared in a century partnership with Ellie Mason.

Several appearances here for different members of Nantwich's prolific attack, but the top spot goes to Sophie Morris, who moved ahead by taking six wickets in the final match. Her final tally is just one behind the official league record of 24, which is still held by Wistaston Village's Hannah Thornhill from 2013's second division; and matches the 23 wickets bagged by Annie Rashid of Appleton in the first division in 2015. However, both of those were achieved in a 12-match season, making Morris' haul the largest achieved in a 10-match season.
