Round-Up

The Newsletter is updated as of the games on Saturday 4th May. One of the reasons to move to 12 teams divisions was to keep games competitive going to the end of the season with minimal number of "dead rubbers" - this past weekend saw some decided and there is still many other deciding games to take place!

Premier Division

Bridgend St have guaranteed a top 2 finish and promotion but what they probably did not expect was it would come following 2 end of season defeats! FC Cwmaman can win the title and need 2 pts from their final 3 games - but not a formality playing Tonyrefail BGC (who have a relegation battle), Treherbert BGC Cardiff Airport. Dinas Powys were already relegated but Caerphilly Athletic (beating Bridgend St) and Llanrumney Utd (beating Aber Valley) mean Tonyrefail BGC need that win against FC Cwmaman in their final game!

Championship

The Champions, Runners-Up and subsequent promotion places were decided on 27 April - congratulations to Ely Rangers who, until Saturday, last lost a league game back on 14 October - to Runners Up Llantwit Fardre. Ely Rangers scoring 87 goals in the process - averaging over 4 goals per game- 48 coming from the strike partnership of Richard Greaves (26) and Alex Long (22).Llantwit Fardre's Ryan Prosser splitting the Ely Rangers pair with 25 and has one final game left to take the top spot. Relegation places are Garw BGC and Sully Sports. The latter needing a win in their local derby against Vale United but despite twice leading lost 3-2. The final place is between Aberfan and rivals Merthyr Saints however Aberfan need to beat Llantwit Fardre!

Division One - West

Congratulations to Afan United winning the D1W title in their first SWAL season! But the 2nd promotion place is between Cardiff Bay Warriors and Tata Steel United. Relegation is a "Pick 'Em" with Canton Rangers already relegated, leaving one from Cogan Coronation, Grange Albion & Fairwater.

DINAS POWYS FC

Dinas Powys came into the SW Alliance League this season after relegation from the Ardal League. The club were formed in 1971 and promoted into the former SW Amateur League in 1990, becoming champions in 1998. In 1999-2000 Dinas Powys were promoted to the then Welsh League when they defeated Bettws in the SWFA Play-Off 2-1.

Success continued and in 2007-2008 they finished runners-up to Goytre Utd in Division 1. Dinas won't need to be reminded of their first season in the Alliance Premier Division - which has been a very difficult one to say the least - however in March they finally secured their first point against Aber Valley before - on a Wednesday evening the 10th April - their fist league victory of the season finally came with a 3-1 win against their Vale of Glamorgan rivals Cardiff Airport.

Well done for sticking with the difficult season!




