### FAW Fair Play Promotion

In addition to the Further Misconduct Discipline Points, the FAW will this season, introduce a system which will allow the Discipline Department to deduct discipline points in instances where clubs have evidenced their promotion of FAW Fair Play.

Below we have provided details of the relevant ways in which clubs can

<b>Online Articles</b> Displaying tables, logo and Code. Tables to be displayed monthly and Code annually. (1) Displaying Logo and Code/Award details (2) Displaying monthly Tables (3) Displaying all of the above	2 4 6
<b>Designated Fair Play Days</b> The display of Fair Play Cards, delivery of Fair Play Message over PA System, T-shirts, Banners etc.	6
<b>Poster Campaign</b> The display of posters in the Clubhouse and changing rooms etc.	6
<b>Other</b> Clubs have the opportunity to suggest other ideas as we encourage the Fair Play Message to be shared through whatever means possible.	2 - 6

All of the above must be evidenced and either posted or emailed to the FAW Compliance Department.

All evidence that has been submitted will be reviewed at the end of the season and any deduction in Discipline Points will be represented in the final tables of the season.

<b>38.1.1*</b> Violation of Laws/Rules/Regulations <b>Offence</b> (i) Breach of suspension by Participant (ii) Breach of Section H	12
<b>38.1.3</b> Play with/against suspended club	12
<b>38.1.6*</b> Allow director/official/referee/assistant/player to breach a suspension.	12
<b>38.1.9</b> Acts or comments likely to bring the game into disrepute - before, during or after a match. A charge pursuant to the Regulations Governing Assaults on Match Officials.	12 15
<b>38.1.10</b> Any act or omission constituting a "Doping Offence" as defined in the Association's Anti-Doping Regulations.	15
<b>38.1.11</b> If more than two (2) members of a club are found to have committed a "Doping Offence" (as defined in Rule 38.1.10)	15
<b>38.1.13</b> Fail to conduct themselves in a orderly fashion or fail to refrain from violence/ Players/Club Officials/Spectators)	12
<b>38.1.14</b> Encroach on the pitch area. (Spectators)	10
<b>38.1.15</b> Throw Missiles (Spectators)	12
<b>38.1.16</b> Fail to ensure that a private way	10

\*When multiple charges are issued against a Club and/or Player in relation to the same offence, a maximum of 12 points will be added to the Club's record.
