## REVIEW OF THE WEEK

### PLAY-OFFS | DOODSON SPORT CUP FINAL

The Evo-Stik NPL season was rounded off on Sunday, as Bradford Park Avenue beat FC United of Manchester 1-0 after extra time to secure promotion to the Blue Square Bet North for the 2012/13 season. Tom Greaves' 118th minute strike was enough to seal the win for Park Avenue, who kept clean sheets in each of their play-off games following last Saturday's 5-0 win over Hedgesford Town. For FC United, it was heartbreak for the second successive year. After a 2-0 win at Chorley in the semi-final, Karl Marginson's men fell to the same fate as last season, where they lost the play-off final to Colwyn Bay.

Witton Albion won the First Division North play-offs, and will return to the Premier Division after three seasons away. A 3-0 win over Farsley FC in the semi-final was matched by the same score line in the final, with an Ashley Stott brace and a goal from Alex Titchiner enough to see off Curzon Ashton, who had scraped past Garforth Town on penalties in the other semi-final.

Ilkeston FC complete the line-up of play-off winners after a 2-0 win over Leek Town in the First Division South final. Like both of the other play-off winners, the Robins didn't concede a goal in either of their play-off games, and made their intentions clear with a 7-0 drubbing of Sheffield FC on the opening night of the post-season. After going 120 minutes in heavy conditions at Carlton Town for a 7-6 penalty shoot-out win, Leek Town gave a great showing in the final, but couldn't match their performance against the divisional runners-up.

Last Saturday also saw the first ever Doodson Sport Cup final, with North Ferriby United running out 4-1 winners over Rushall Olympic after extra time. Following a tense 90 minutes in which both teams scored from the penalty spot, extra time strikes from Tim Taylor, Gregg Anderson and Chris Bolder gave the Villagers their first "league cup" trophy.

## NEWS IN BRIEF

# SUMMER MANAGERIAL CHANGES BEGIN

The managerial merry-go-round is once again spinning now that the season is completed, with several managerial positions either available or with new incumbents;

### **Frickley Athletic**

Peter Rinkcavage and his assistant Jason Maybury are to leave the South Yorkshire side following tomorrow night's Sheffield and Hallamshire FA Senior Cup final.

The position is currently vacant, and the club statement read; "(We) are looking for someone who can turn the club's on the field fortunes around. Ideally, applicants will be experienced within senior semi-professional football with the ability, drive and enthusiasm to succeed at this level of football."

Another team that competed at Premier Division level this season - Chasetown - closed their application process last week, and an announcement is expected shortly

### **Sheffield FC**

First Division South side Sheffield FC have appointed Curtis Woodhouse as their new manager, replacing Mark Shaw.

Curtis is currently a professional boxer, but the former footballer counts Sheffield United, Birmingham City and Hull City amongst his former clubs, and will announce his backroom staff in due course.

In a statement released to the league today, the club announced, "I'm sure all supporters will join us in wishing him all the best and hope his appointment gives Sheffield FC a fighting chance, pardon the pun, of improving on last season's excellent efforts. Welcome (back) to the club Curtis."

### **Ossett Town**

Ossett Town are looking to appoint a permanent football manager following the departure of Phil Sharpe earlier this year. Eric Gilchrist took over as caretaker manager when Phil left, and a permanent appointment is now being made.

James Rogers, Vice Chairman said, "Ossett Town AFC is a club with great prospects and opportunities for the future. We are actively progressing the development of a new ground and training facilities and have a thriving and successful junior section. This is an exciting opportunity for the right candidate to come and work with us to help achieve our ambitions for both football and the local community."

### **Hucknall Town**

Des Lyttle has quit Hucknall Town as the club looks to rebuild for the 2012/13 season. Lyttle joined the club in October 2011, and has been faced with a tight budget throughout his tenure.

Speaking to the Hucknall Dispatch, the 40-year old said, "I didn't want to try and start something and then leave pre-season or ten games into the season. It's time for the club to get someone local in to try and move the place forward. It is my decision 100% and nothing to do with the club."

Drury, who recently left Corby Town, will return for a second spell with the Daniels after previously being in charge between 2005 and 2008 before leaving to manage the Steelmen. He will be assisted by his former Daniels and Corby number two, Paul Holden.

# LEAGUE FAIR PLAY AWARDS

The final monthly Fair Play awards of the season have gone to ASHTON UNITED, BAMBER BRIDGE and GOOLE respectively. Ashton, with three cautions in five games, were winning the Premier Division prize for the second month in succession whilst "Brig" belied their lowly overall season disciplinary record in the First Division North to incur just one a caution during April. In the First Division South both Goole and Stamford also had just one caution recorded against them in the month and as both also identical Technical Area marks the award went to Goole on their better overall season to date record.

Ashton's successive monthly awards in March and April propelled the club well clear of their nearest rivals in the race for the Premier Division overall season prize of £1,000 to complete a most remarkable story. Last season the Hurst Cross club had finished rock bottom of the Fair Play table but Chairman Dave Aspinall and his Board decided that something had to be done. During the close season they worked with manager Danny Johnson to improve the club's disciplinary record and succeeded to such an extent that they have scooped the top prize all of which goes to prove that if there is a will then there is a way. Chasetown and Whitby Town had identical records in second and third places and share £750.

There was also a remarkable a story in the First Division North where no fewer than three clubs recorded less than one caution per game throughout the season which ended with last year's FA National Respect and Fair Play winners Lancaster City landing the First Division North £1,000 Fair Play cash for an incredible third season in succession. Witton Albion edged this year's FA National Respect and Fair Play winners AFC Fylde out of second spot by the narrowest of margins averaging 0.94 disciplinary points per game against 0.95. Albion pocket £500 whilst Fylde take home £250.

First Division South Fair Play winners Leek Town also recorded less than a caution a game but with an average of 0.88 disciplinary points per game were 0.01 points behind Lancaster for the best record overall in the League meaning that the President's Cup for Fair Play goes to Lancaster City by the narrowest of margins. Brigg Town took second place in this Division with new club Ilkeston adding third place in the Fair Play table to their second position out on the pitch.

This season saw the League as part of its Respect Programme put up £4,000 in prize money to go the clubs in each of the three Divisions that had least dissent cautions / foul and abusive language dismissals in all competitions including the League Cup, FA Cup and FA Trophy in addition to League fixtures. Premier Division champions Chester FC won the top tier first prize of £750 with just three dissent cautions whilst Nantwich Town and Stafford Rangers shared the second and third place money with four cautions each.

Curzon Ashton and Witton Albion who contested the First Division North Play-Off Final shared first and second place prize money in that Division's Respect awards and with only two cautions each in the entire season in all competitions. Another club involved in the play-offs, Farsley FC, shared third place prize money with Trafford on three cautions.

In the First Division South Leek Town pocketed another £750 for winning that Division's Respect prize money with just three dissent cautions in all games whilst Goole and Romulus shared second and third place prize money with four cautions/ dismissals. Goole, like Ashton, have enjoyed an extraordinary turn around discipline wise this season. Year after year Goole have had a very poor record on discipline and have usually finished in the bottom three season on season. But their excellent record on cutting out dissent this season has seen them improve in the overall Fair Play table to a very creditable fourth place.

The Football Association today announced the winners of the 2011/12 National Respect and Fair Play awards with the Northern Premier League for the third season in succession figuring prominently.

Although the NPL did not achieve a hat-trick of successes in the League awards which they had dominated in the past two years AFC FYLDE did make it three on the bounce for NPL sides when they landed the Club Award for Steps 1-4 following Garforth Town and Lancaster City's achievements in 2010 and 2011. In the League Awards the NPL took silver place which gives it the choice of some fantastic rewards.

Adding to Fylde's success was the NPL's Respect Manager Phil Bradley who won the prestigious Bobby Moore Individual Award for the work he has done in driving the NPL's Respect Programme that has now brought the League six winners in the three years since the Awards were first contested.

Since Phil began his work on the League's Respect Programme three years ago the NPL has a 100% success record in the Club Awards and had won the Step 1-4 Leagues National Award in each of the previous two seasons.
