# PITTORMIE CASTLE

This magnificent baronial castle is set amongst some of Scotland's finest grounds featuring private walled gardens, manicured lawns and towering trees.

Ideally situated just minutes from The Old Course at St Andrews, Scotland, The Eden Club at Pittormie Castle is a luxurious private retreat.

The Castle offers a variety of luxury activities and amenities from gourmet dining to horseback riding, fishing and more, as well as access to the many exquisite links courses located in and around the 'home of golf'.

Originally constructed in the 16th century and formerly the ancestral home of the Duke of Fife, the baronial castle was lovingly restored in 2005 under the guidance of Historic Scotland. Today it is truly a one of a kind luxury destination, combining old-world charm and beauty, warm personal service, and a rare opportunity to explore the breath-taking landscape where golf was first born centuries ago.

Accommodation is available across the castles eight bedrooms and 10, two and three bedroom residences. With a team of dedicated hospitality staff on duty 24 hours a day our focus is on a higher level of service. Our fleet of private Range Rover's and Mercedes with Club drivers will organise all of your transfers, leaving you to enjoy the service and style of a fine private club.



## THE RESIDENCES

Within the estate, a short walk from the Castle, the old stables, steadings and cottages have been developed into luxurious two and three bedroom residences. Whilst identical in style and design they range in layout and size from ca. 1,400 to 2,800 square foot. Each residence was built to a superior quality using the finest woods, marble and stone.







## NORTH PARK COTTAGE

## THINGS TO DO IN THE LOCAL AREA

### Golf

Nowhere else in the world would you find such a concentration of special golf courses as in Scotland, the historical setting of the home of golf. With 38 different courses within 45 minutes of the Castle to choose from, you are certainly not short of options. Boasting some of the finest links courses in the world, the local area features classic courses such as Carnoustie, Kingsbarns and The Old Course. In addition to the classics we have selected a number of other great local tracks and some hidden gems for you to experience on at least one of your visits to Pittormie. The Concierge can arrange tee times for you on the area courses and equipment can be rented from the Castle (fees will apply). We will gladly assist in arranging caddies, carts, and chauffeured transfers for you prior to your arrival.

### Edinburgh

This cosmopolitan city, the capital of Scotland, rests just 45 minutes south of Pittormie and can be easily reached by car or by train. Highlights of any visit to Edinburgh include the medieval Old Town and the Georgian New Town (a combined UNESCO World Heritage Site), a thousand year old cathedral and Scotland's National Museum. There is also a wide range of dining options and a mix of stylish boutiques and designer showrooms sure to delight shopping enthusiasts.



### Golf museum – St Andrews

The five-star British Golf Museum sits at the heart of the home of golf, just 67 yards from the famous Old Course. Imaginative exhibitions, hands on activities and stunning multimedia displays bring to life over 500 years of golfing history. The British Golf Museum is the world's premier heritage centre for golf.

### St Andrews Cathedral and Castle

The cathedral buildings are surrounded by a graveyard and encircled by the most complete and imposing monastic enclosure walls in Scotland. Even in its ruinous state, the cathedral remains a prominent landmark. On a headland to the north of St Andrews stand the ruins of the city's castle, the main residence of the bishops and archbishops of St Andrews and the focal point of the Church in Medieval Scotland. A highlight of a visit to the castle is The Bottle Dungeon, one of the most infamous castle prisons in medieval Britain, carved out of the solid rock.



### Falkland Palace

The Royal Palace of Falkland, built between 1502 and 1541 and set in the heart of a unique medieval village, was the country residence and hunting lodge of eight Stuart monarchs, including Mary, Queen of Scots. The Palace is famous for its beautiful gardens and for the Real Tennis court, built in 1539.

### Glamis Castle

Whether you choose to visit Glamis to admire its stunning architecture, to explore its history, legends, and myths, or simply to enjoy the beauty of the surrounding grounds and gardens, you will not fail to be touched by the magic of Glamis. The castle, which was the childhood home of the late Queen Mother and is famed as the setting for Shakespeare's 'Macbeth', is situated in the fertile valley of Strathmore, only 30 minutes from Pittormie.



### Scottish Clay Shooting Centre

Located within just a 15 minute drive from Pittormie, the Scottish Clay Shooting Centre is one of the leading clay grounds in the country and is well known for its ability to cater for everyone. So whether you're a novice or a crack-shot, you will enjoy and benefit from time spent here. The centre offers the very best in terms of sporting clays facilities and equipment and shooting can be enjoyed by all members of the family. Instruction and all necessary equipment are supplied and guest at Pittormie can also utilise the Castles' own selection of top quality Beretta shotguns and the services of our Director of shooting.



## GENERAL INFORMATION

### **Location**

Pittormie lies in the heart of north east Fife amongst some of the most glorious and unspoiled fertile farmland of Scotland's most productive counties. It is within 4 miles of the beautiful East Neuk of Fife coastline with its sandy beaches, birdlife and fine flora.

Just 45 minutes from Edinburgh Airport and 15 minutes from Dundee, Pittormie is also just three minutes from Leuchars, the local private airport. In addition, its close proximity to the town of St Andrews (five minutes via car) makes it one of Scotland's best placed destinations.

### **Time Zone**

Scotland is in the Greenwich Mean Time Zone, which is five hours ahead of (later than) New York. Daylight Saving Time is observed.

### **Climate**

St Andrews' climate is relatively temperate with moderate humidity and less yearly rainfall than most locations in Scotland, thanks to the mountain ranges to the west that shelter St Andrews from Atlantic weather systems. Winter temperatures can drop to freezing, but snow is rare and temperatures are generally coolly comfortable in summer and remain moderate through the rest of the year.
