Formerly the home of the first Duke of Fife, having been given to Ludovic of Lennox by King James VI in 1596, the Castle was lovingly restored by The Eden Club in 2005 under the guidance of Historic Scotland.

BEDROOMS

Within the Castle there are eight suites, each uniquely designed and decorated with their own en-suite bathroom. Furnished to the highest specifications, each room is as relaxing as it is delightful. 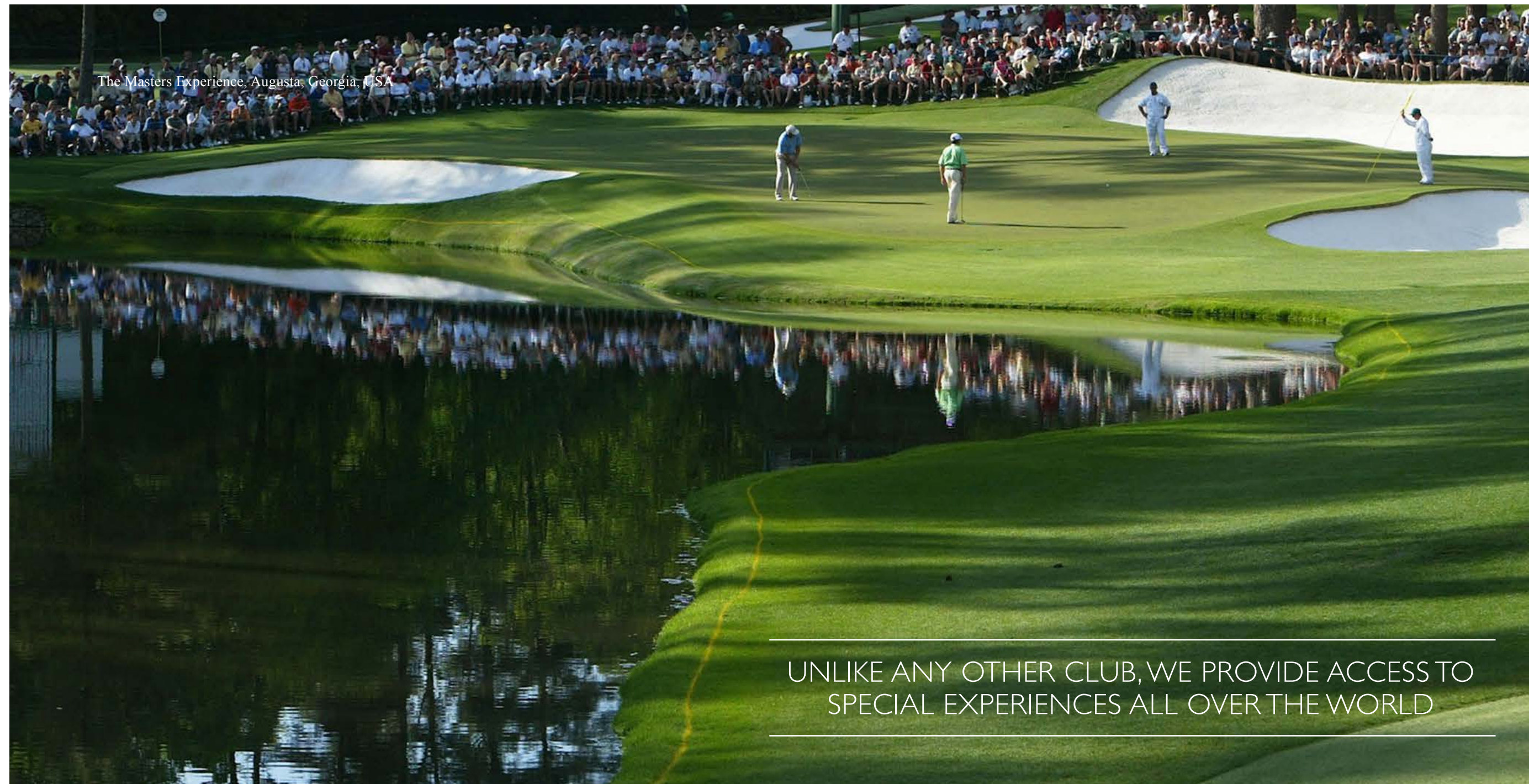
THE SECRETARIAT
