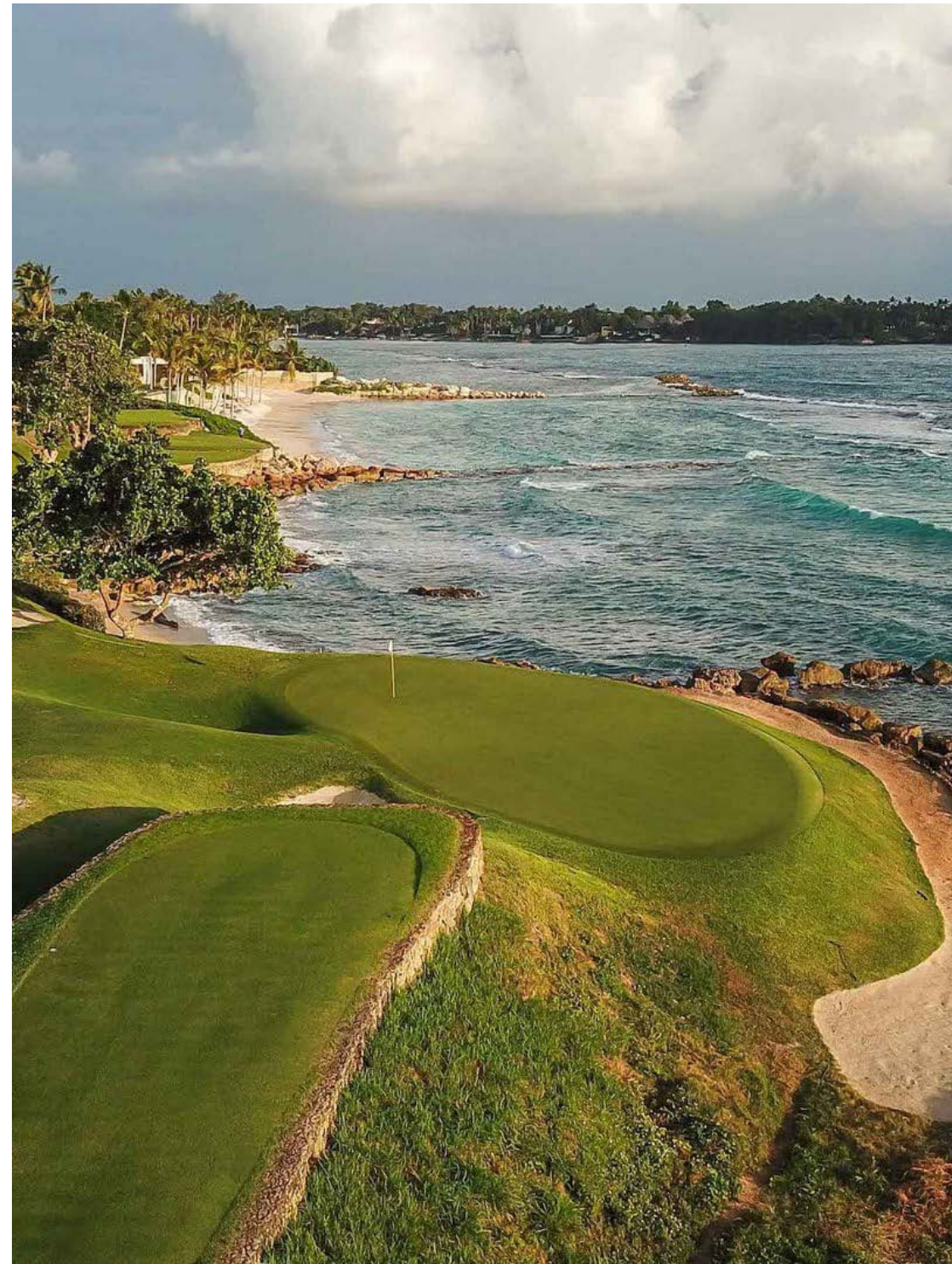

THE OPEN CHAMPIONSHIP

16th - 19th July

Royal Birkdale

In 2026, Royal Birkdale will once again take its place on golf's grandest stage as host of the 154th Open Championship, reaffirming its status as one of the world's premier championship venues. With its exceptional links, Birkdale will provide a stern yet fair test for the game's finest players as they vie for the Claret Jug.

Founded in 1889 and elegantly reimaged in 1922, Royal Birkdale has earned a reputation as one of The Open's most revered and exacting courses. Threading its way through majestic sand dunes along England's northwest coast, the layout combines natural beauty with strategic brilliance. Since first hosting The Open in 1954, it has become the Championship's most frequent venue outside of St Andrews. Among its many storied moments, Jordan Spieth's dramatic 2017 triumph over Matt Kuchar stands as a modern classic in Open history.

Northern Scotland, Nairn, Moray Old

Evenings culminate in a Gala Dinner at Pittormie Castle, complete with piping, fine Scottish cuisine, live music, and the prize-giving. Guests are invited to embrace tradition in kilts and evening dress, making this a truly memorable celebration of golf, fellowship, and The Eden Club spirit.

ASIA CLASSIC

TBC November

Sai Kung, Hong Kong
The Clearwater Bay Golf & Country Club

Perched atop a rugged cliff on the southern tip of Hong Kong's Sai Kung peninsula, Clearwater Bay Golf & Country Club has been described by former world No. 1 Justin Rose as "the Pebble Beach of Asia." Its breathtaking coastal setting, dramatic sea views, and championship-calibre layout make it one of the region's most distinguished golfing experiences.

The course presents two contrasting nines: the front "Ocean" nine opens with four exhilarating seaside holes, including the signature 220-yard par-4 3rd that demands a bold drive over the South China Sea. The back "Highland" nine weaves through the natural contours of the land, with elevated greens, intimate valleys, and memorable finishing holes, most notably the 13th and 18th, that test both strategy and nerve. Renovations by the Australian firm Thompson Perrett in 2006 brought the course fully up to tournament standards.

With its elegant clubhouse, panoramic ocean views, and a semi-private policy welcoming guests by introduction, Clearwater Bay offers an exceptional combination of challenge, beauty, and exclusivity – making it a rare and unforgettable destination for Eden Members and invited guests alike.
