Israeli Government Set to Begin Regularization Procedures for Dozens of Illegal Outposts

May 4, 2023

The Israeli government has set annexation and regularization of illegal outposts in the West Bank as a central item on its agenda and is now working vigorously to achieve this goal.

According to a [publication by Israel Hayom](#) newspaper, the procedures for retroactive **regularization of at least 70 illegal outposts** in the West Bank will begin within a few weeks. This initiative is based on the decision of the State Security Cabinet from February 12, 2023. **The government intends to regularize most of these outposts within 2-3 years.**
