Background:

Following the <u>recent developments</u> in the illegal outpost Homesh, including government-led efforts to re-establish it as a settlement, we invite you to join a virtual briefing on June 19th to learn about the legal

status of Homesh and our ongoing High Court petition. The speakers will include Adv. Shlomy Zachary, who represents the residents of Burqa in their legal struggle against the outpost, and Shady Zahi, a resident of Burqa.

On June 13th, the State is expected to submit its response to the petition and the order nisi issued by the justices after the previous hearing in January, in which it must explain why it has not acted to remove the illegal construction in Homesh and why it does not take all the necessary actions to ensure the free access of the landowners to their lands.

Join us for an update on the most recent developments in Homesh as Israel blatantly violates its own laws and commitments to satisfy the settler lobby and rewards the criminals for their efforts in Homesh.
