Analysis of the appendices to the coalition agreements signed between the Likud and the Religious Zionism and Otzma Yehudit parties

December 15, 2022

Today, Yesh Din, The Association for Civil Rights in Israel, Breaking the Silence, and Ofek - The Israeli Center for Public Affairs are releasing a joint analysis of coalition agreements appendices, signed on December 1 between the Likud and the Religious Zionism and Otzma Yehudit parties.

Please note that this working document focuses on the fundamental changes to Israeli control in the occupied Palestinian territory as they appear in the appendices to the coalition agreements which have already been signed.

Whether these agreements are applied in full or not, we view the agreements signed as a declaration of intent to apply far-reaching changes to the structure of the regime in Israel and to the nature of control over the West Bank, and therefore we believe it is important to present them and analyse the anticipated consequences on the lives and futures of millions of Palestinians living under Israeli occupation.
