
These are the Palestinian communities That Were Attacked between October 7-22

Yesh Din has mapped which Palestinian communities in the West Bank have been attacked by Israeli settlers between Oct. 7-22. Since October 7, more than 100 attacks have been carried out in at least 62 towns and villages in the West Bank, at times accompanied by soldiers. Israeli settlers have killed at least six Palestinians with live ammunition, displaced shepherd communities from their lands, set homes and vehicles on fire, uprooted trees, and destroyed property. To Yesh Din's knowledge, out of the hundreds of settlers involved in these attacks, not a single one has been detained, investigated, or arrested in relation to these incidents. This is not a failure of law enforcement in the West Bank but rather policy of the GOI that supports the violent acts carried out by settlers against innocent

Palestinians. Since October 7, 96 Palestinians have been killed in the West Bank by Israeli security forces and settlers.
