Yesh Din, together with the petitioners from Burqa, invite you to attend a High Court hearing in [HCJ 2821/19](#), demanding the evacuation of the illegal outpost Homesh.

The hearing will take place Thursday, August 3, 2023 at 13:00 in Israel's High Court of Justice in Jerusalem.

Following the previous High Court hearing in January, the justices issued an *order nisi* in favor of the petitioners, demanding that the State explain why it has not evacuated the outpost and restored proper access to the land to its rightful landowners. Since then, the GOI has cancelled relevant sections of the 2005 Disengagement Law, approved the transfer of outpost structures onto nearby State Lands without proper planning procedures and in violation of Israeli law, and allocated large swaths of land in the area to the Samaria Regional Council in preparation for the establishment of a new

settlement. In the meantime, settlers squatting in the outpost have maintained a continuous presence, continue to commit violent attacks against the residents of Burqa and to prevent them from accessing their lands.

And now, in this ominous moment for Israel's judiciary, the High Court must choose between capitulating to the State's political demands and issuing a clear ruling: Homesh must be evacuated immediately and the rightful Palestinian landowners must be ensured renewed access to the lands that have been stolen from them.
