Invitation to an urgent diplomatic briefing on the dangerous escalation in violations of rights of Palestinians in Israel, Gaza, and the West Bank

Yesh Din, together with six leading Israeli human rights organizations, invites you to attend an urgent diplomatic briefing to address the widespread violations of the rights of Palestinians in Israel, Gaza, and the West Bank during the current war.

Following Hamas's attack on October 7, and while the international spotlight is on Israel's aerial assault and the ensuing humanitarian crisis in Gaza, Israel's extreme-right government has pursued a radical agenda to violate the rights of Palestinians in prisons, in the West Bank, and within Israel. This includes a dramatic increase in settler-violence and forcible transfer, crackdown on freedom of speech and uptick in arrests of Palestinian citizens, denial of legal and family visits to Palestinians held in Israeli Prison Service settings, measures to adversely impact the health and well-being of Palestinians in incarceration, wholesale detention of Palestinians and ongoing West Bank closures that grievously harm the livelihood of

Palestinians.


