# THE INITIATIVE

Started back in 2016, **Towards Zero Waste** is a dedicated sustainability initiative set to **minimize the environmental impact** derived from the celebration of our events. We're working towards creating efficient, inclusive and sustainable cities - so naturally, our events should lead by example!

**Our Zero Waste Strategy is mainly based on:**

 **Circularity**

 **Recycling**

 **No single-use plastics and less paper**

 **Renewable energies and CO2 compensation**





# WHAT DO WE DO?



## Circular design

Our venue decoration follows a fully circular design approach. This year, every decorative element was crafted from **post-consumer recycled cardboard**, while all furniture was rented to ensure continuous reuse.



## Planting trees for the planet

Year after year, we partner with **Plant-for-the-Planet** to support reforestation initiatives and raise awareness about the global climate emergency. Last year, proceeds from merchandise sales funded the planting of **1.152 new trees**. Since the initiative began in 2022, we've planted a total of 3.773 trees!



## Waste management

**Waste separation stations** are strategically placed across both halls, with dedicated volunteers ensuring every visitor plays a part in keeping the event green. Last year, there was a total of **1.6 tons of waste** selectively collected.



## No single-use plastics

Again, we got rid of all **single-use plastics** in our venue and provided water stations for free refills.



## Carpet recycled

All carpets from corridors, common areas, and Servifira stands are **100% recycled** after the event. In total, last year we repurposed **12.260 tons** of recycled carpet material.



## No food waste

Retrieved food is collected and donated to the NGO **Nutrition Without Borders**, which distributes it through community kitchens.



## Using less paper

In order to reduce our paper use, we exclusively use the event app for all the event information – last year's edition hit **31.850 downloads**. Additionally, our media partners offered their publications via QR codes at the Press Corners.



## Tons of recycling

Every piece of leftover wood, fabric, and organic material is carefully recycled, ensuring zero waste. Last year, we recycled **more than 10 tons of material**.





## Sustainable travel

We encourage visitors to get around Barcelona sustainably by offering a **parking area for bikes** and scooters and discounts on public transport.



## Green venue

Fira de Barcelona uses only **renewable electricity**, including solar, wind, and geothermal sources. The venue has one of the biggest rooftop photovoltaic plants in the world: **25.947 solar panels** covering 135.000 m<sup>2</sup>, generating 5.86 GWh of electricity per year, preventing the emission of over **2.200 tons** of CO<sub>2</sub> annually.

# SOLIDARITY SHOP

Our Solidarity Shop offers exclusive merch to help fund our tree-planting efforts:

For the forth consecutive year, we have partnered with **Plant for the Planet** to support the reforestation project of **Doñana National Park**, Spain's most emblematic biodiversity hot spot, and one of the most important protected natural areas in Europe.

## Roots for a sustainable future

For every €6 spent at our shop, we donated 1 tree to Doñana's reforestation program.

## Impact from 2022 to 2025

- A total of **3.773 planted trees**: Pinus, Olea, Quercus, Pistacea, Chamaerops, Rhamnus and Phillyrea.
- Expansion of the reforestation plot over **3 hectares**.





# GREEN VENUE

We power our venue and offices entirely with renewable energy, **reducing CO2 emissions by 12,500 tons** annually. Our venue also hosts one of the world's largest rooftop photovoltaic plants—**25,947 panels over 135,000 m<sup>2</sup>**, generating **5.86 GWh per year** and preventing **2,200+ tons of CO2 emissions**. Fira de Barcelona also leads in Spain by implementing IoT technology for energy optimization and installing low-consumption lighting systems.







# CIRCULARITY

This year, our **event decoration strategy** was built around circular design and material responsibility, ensuring that all elements could be **reused or recycled** after the event.

- 🔄 **Cardboard structures** made from honeycomb kraft core of post-consumer recycled fiber: 100% recycled and fully recyclable.
- 🔄 **3,000+ kg** of material recycled after the event.
- 🔄 **1,500+ kg** redistributed to Viladecans City Council and local Ateneus for public reuse.
- 🔄 **4,450+ kg** of material reused, representing 100% of seating elements used across congress and stages.

Through this approach, we significantly reduced waste generation while extending the lifecycle of our event materials, **combining environmental responsibility with social value and community impact.**





# GREEN EXHIBITOR AWARD

The Green Exhibitor Award celebrates exhibitors who actively work to reduce their environmental impact. In line with our **Towards Zero Waste** initiative, this award aims to raise awareness and promote responsible participation throughout the event.
