Introduction

Fulham Football Club has undertaken a detailed review of our workforce composition. This annual data collection is a key tool in helping us better understand the people who lead our Club from boardroom to operational delivery and ensures we remain aligned with both regulatory expectations and our own organisational values.

This exercise focuses on our permanent workforce, including senior leaders, operational staff, and coaching teams, across both the Club and our Foundation. It enables us to reflect on how we're progressing towards our wider Equality, Diversity, and Inclusion ("EDI") objectives set out in our **'Fulham For All' Strategy** and where there are opportunities to strengthen representation and support across all areas of the Club.

By gathering insights across several key characteristics, we are better placed to build a workplace where individuals feel seen, supported, and valued. This work also supports a more evidence informed approach to our recruitment, staff development, and inclusive leadership efforts.

Our data return rates were strong across all staff groups, a reflection of growing trust in this process and our shared commitment to creating a culture of fairness and accountability. We continue to compare our workforce profile against national benchmarks and, where appropriate, local population data, to better understand our position and potential impact within the broader community we serve.

Definitions

Board and Staff: All permanent staff members directly employed by the club and all Board members.

Senior leadership: Clubs have very different structures, so it is up to the clubs to decide their own approach. We recommend that senior leadership applies to the top 25% of earners (excluding coaches, excluding Board members). Clubs may want to include middle management in their targets.

Other employees: All permanent employees (excluding coaches, excluding Board members) who do not fall in the senior leadership category.

Senior Coaching Staff: Clubs will have different coaching structures and are able to self-declare what is considered a senior position. Typically, these senior positions include first team, U23s, U21s and U18s. We recommend it applies to the top 25% of earners with the coaching structure.

Other Coaching Staff: All permanent coaching staff who do not fall in the senior coaching staff category.

National Comparison Data: Latest data from ONS (or other relevant source; source should be stated)

Local Comparison Data: Latest data from local or regional analysis (source should be stated). This data is optional, but clubs may like to use it to provide a comparison to their community.

Data Collection methodology

Included staff: All permanent members of staff directly employed by the Club and all Board members. This excludes those only employed for event day operations.

This also excludes those who work solely in the women's game (who will be covered by WSL and WC reporting). Those members of staff with a dual role in men's and women's football are included.

For staff who work in the CCO, include them but report as a separate workforce group.

Collection rate: Clubs should ensure best endeavours to achieve a collection rate of 80% of the included staff workforce.
