BUYING YOUR TICKET

Ticket information, pricing and dates of sale for individual fixtures is available at hibernianfc.co.uk/matches/womens-squad-fixtures

Home tickets go on sale approximately 2-3 weeks in advance.

Hibernian Women Home Ticket Prices:

Adults: £8

Student £6

Concession: £4- Concessions include: Under-18s, Over-65s, Disabled Supporters.

Away tickets for Hibs Women matches can be purchased from the host club, with home and away seating not segregated at women's matches.

You can purchase tickets for fixtures at Meadowbank:

Using our Fanbase platform Tickets can be purchased online up until kick-off and mobile tickets will be sent to supporters' email accounts.

OR

We also accept card only payment at the gate on the day of the game.



DIRECTIONS TO THE STADIUM

By Car

From the East, follow A1, at the roundabout, take the 2nd exit onto Milton Link, turn left onto Duddingston Crescent, turn left onto Wolseley Terrace, turn right into Meadowbank Stadium carpark.

From the West, Join Queen Street, continue onto York Place, turn right onto London Road, keep left onto Cadzow Place, turn left into Meadowbank Stadium Carpark.

By Bus

The following Lothain Busses stop outside Meadowbank Stadium - 26, 34, 4, 44, 5. Head to their website for the latest timetables.

By Train

The ground is 30 minutes walk from Waverly Train Station.



CAR PARKING

Supporters parking is often limited at Meadowbank due to other events and activities taking place within the building.

Should the car park become full, there is local street parking within walking distance to Meadowbank. Please be aware that the surrounding areas are controlled by pay and display or permit holder only restrictions.

USING THE CAR PARK AT MEADOWBANK SPORTS CENTRE

ARRIVING AT MEADOWBANK CAR PARK



Press the button at the car park barrier to get a ticket - keep it with you during your visit.



Your number plate has been scanned for entry, and the barrier will open.

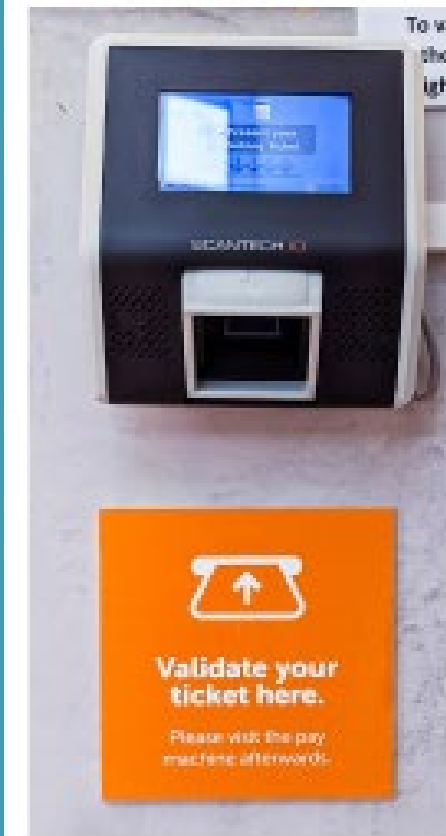


DEPARTING MEADOWBANK CAR PARK

LEAVING AFTER LESS THAN 3 HOURS



Scan your ticket at the box next to reception to validate your ticket.



LEAVING AFTER MORE THAN 3 HOURS



Scan your ticket at the box next to reception to validate your ticket.



Go to payment machine in the exit door vestibule.



Scan your validated ticket and follow instructions for payment.

MEADOWBANK STADIUM

- Meadowbank Stadium has a seated capacity of 499.
- For Hibernian Women matchdays, all supporters will be situated within the stand, with entry via the turnstiles on London Road (opposite McDonalds).
- We recommend tickets to be purchased in advance to avoid queues at the turnstiles on matchday.
- Turnstiles open approximately 60 minutes before the game.
- In a bid to tighten security and ensure every fan contributes to the games excitement, we will continue to use our handstamp policy to confirm entry at the turnstiles.
- Home and away supporters are not segregated at Hibs Women matches.
- There is no allocated seating at Meadowbank, seats are available to all supporters on a first come first served basis.



GROUND REGULATIONS

Flags & Banners

We welcome flags and banners at Meadowbank to increase the matchday atmosphere. Flags or banners of an offensive nature will not be permitted inside the ground.

Prohibited Items

The following items are not permitted inside Meadowbank: alcohol, knives, fireworks, smoke canisters, flares, weapons, dangerous or hazardous items, laser devices, glass vessels, and any item that may be used as a weapon and/or compromise public safety. Any person in possession of such items will be refused entry to the ground.

Smoking

In accordance with Ground Regulations, smoking is not permitted anywhere within Meadowbank Stadium. This also includes the use of electronic cigarettes and vaporisers. Any supporter found in breach of this rule will be subject to the Club's disciplinary procedures, which may result in ejection from the stadium and/or possible further action by the club, including the withdrawal of any season ticket without reimbursement, the withdrawal of the right to purchase a ticket and a stadium ban.



FOOD AND DRINK

Meadowbank Sports Centre café will remain open for supporters attending Hibernian Women fixtures at the stadium. Below is a range of items available for supporters.

Refreshments

- Range of still, sparkling and flavoured water
