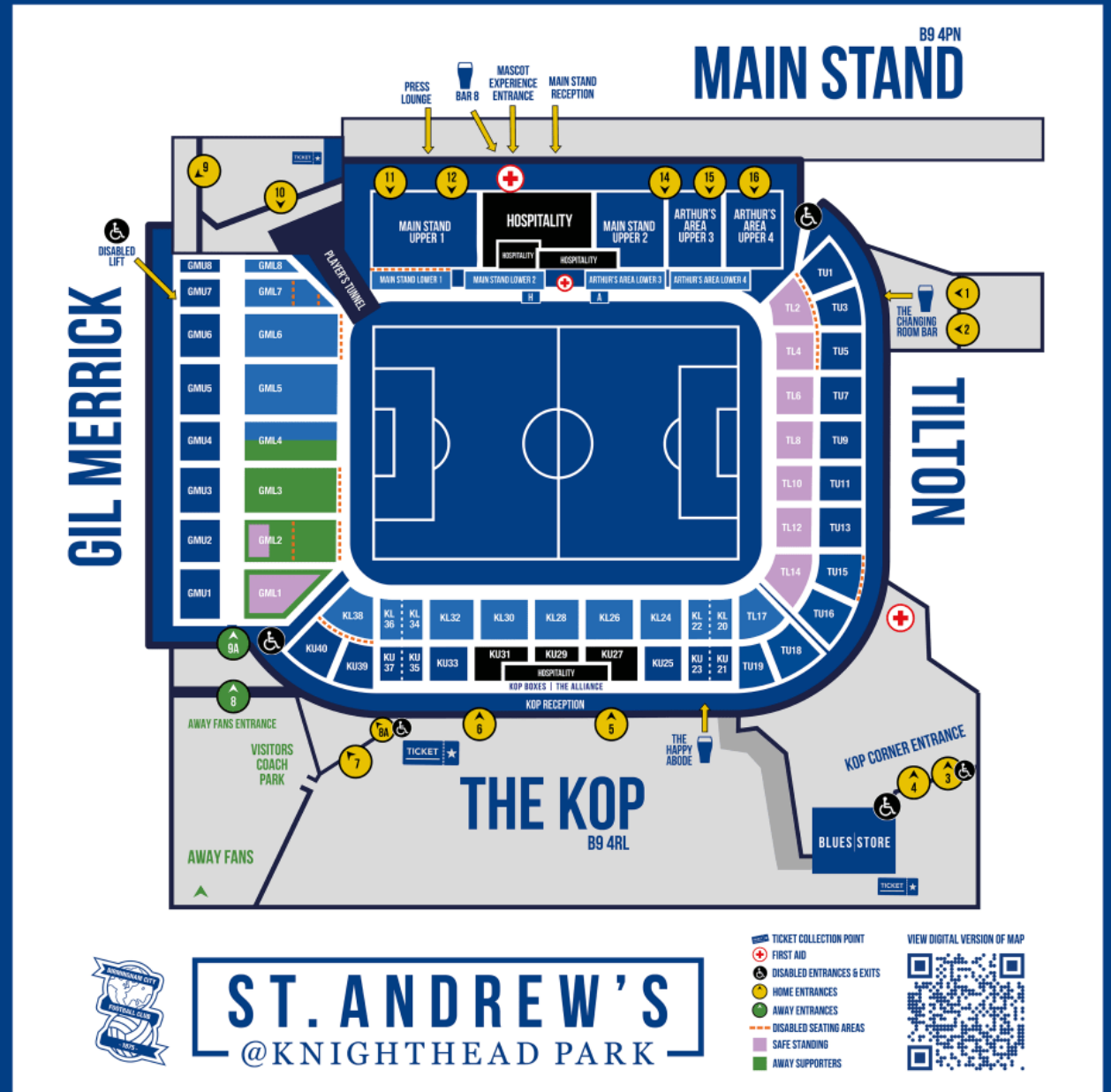

- Adult / Ambulant Adult - £8.00
- Senior - £6.00
- Student / U18 / Ambulant U18- £3.00

All tickets purchased online will incur a £1 per ticket purchased (booking fee) and 0.50p per booking purchased (digital fee).

Tickets will be digital and you are advised to download these prior to arriving at the stadium.

TRAVEL BY TRAIN



There are no planned engineering works on the day of the game if you travel via London. Engineering work is taking place on the line between Stowmarket and Norwich and Bury St Edmunds and Peterborough with rail replacement buses making cross-country routes unfeasible for this game.

Birmingham New Street is just over a half hour walk from St. Andrew's.

It is possible to travel on the day of the game, although it is recognised that many fans may be staying over after the West Brom men's game on Saturday. <https://www.greateranglia.co.uk/> is showing trains leaving Ipswich at 07:35 and 08:41 which connect to the 09:52 and 10:49 trains from London Euston to Birmingham New Street, arriving into Birmingham New Street at 11:48 and 12:48 respectively. To get to London Euston from London Liverpool Street take the Circle Line or Hammersmith and City Line or Metropolitan Line to Euston Square and walk to Euston station. Alternatively, from Moorgate take the Northern Line to Euston.

After the game there are a number of options back from Birmingham New Street to Euston which connect to trains from Liverpool Street to Ipswich.

As mentioned above, engineering works on cross country routes makes this option unfeasible with very lengthy journey times.

Whatever your travel plans, you should check <https://www.greateranglia.co.uk/> or your usual train operator website for updated times.

TRAVEL BY CAR

The Sat Nav postcode for St Andrew's @ Knighthead Park is B9 4RL although you may prefer to use the Sat Nav for your chosen parking.

From Ipswich the route is the A14 to the M6. Leave the M6 at junction 6 and take the A38(M) (Aston Expressway) towards Birmingham City Centre. Leave the A38(M) at the second exit onto the Aston Road/A5127. At the roundabout, take the first exit onto Dartmouth Middleway/A4540. At the next roundabout take the second exit onto Lawley Middleway/A4540. Continue on this road taking the second exit at the next roundabout. At the next roundabout take the first exit on to Garrison Lane. Turn right onto Tilton Road (you will see the ground on your right) and then right onto Cattell Road/B4128. You will see St Andrew's on your right.

Alternatively, instead of taking the exit onto Garrison Lane at the Garrison Circus roundabout, continue on the A4540 (this becomes Watery Lane Middleway). At the next roundabout (there is a McDonalds on the far left hand side) turn left into Coventry Road towards Small Heath. The ground is about a quarter of a mile up this road on the left.

The journey time is at least three hours, but you should allow at least another hour and, ideally 90 minutes beyond the AA / Google / SatNav suggested journey time, to allow for possible delays.

PARKING



Birmingham City offer secure, free parking for supporters attending the match. Parking is limited and will be offered on a first-come, first-served basis.

The car park (marked H on the map) is located on Doris Road, Bordesley, B9 4SJ, just a 10-minute walk from St. Andrews @ Knighthead Park.

The car park will open at 11:30 and will close one hour after the game.

@ KNIGHTHEAD PARK

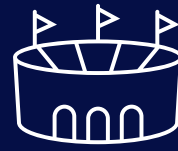

TICKET OFFICE



There is a ticket office at the stadium where tickets can be purchased on the day. We would, however, recommend purchasing in advance. The ticket office can be found to the left of turnstiles 23 to 26 of the Kop Stand.

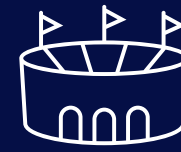
A matchday programme will be available on the day.

BLUES STORE



The Club shop will be open from 10am to 4pm.

GETTING INTO THE STADIUM



TURNSTILES



Turnstiles will open at 12noon. Supporters will enter the stadium and Fan Zone via the main KOP gates, with access through Turnstiles 23, 24, 25, 26 with Gate 6 being the accessible entrance.

SECURITY CHECKS



Full searches are carried out by stewarding staff prior to entry and supporters are urged to arrive at the stadium at least 45 minutes before kick-off in order to avoid delays upon entry. Bags larger than a rucksack (48cm x 33cm) will not be permitted.

FLAGS AND BANNERS



Flags and banners larger than 2M X 1M and/or of an offensive nature are not permitted in the stadium. Please have these ready to be searched.

PYROTECHNICS



As with all grounds and to comply with legislation, the use of pyrotechnics or even trying to get them into the stadium is a criminal offence and will not be tolerated.

INSIDE THE STADIUM

FOOD & DRINK FACILITIES



A range of refreshments are available at the stadium to purchase. The stadium is part of the trial allowing alcohol to be consumed in the stands.

FAN ZONE AND BOX2BOX



The Sports Illustrated Tickets Fan Zone and Box2Box (refreshments and activities) will be open from 12noon and will be accessible once supporters have entered through the turnstiles.



Once inside the stadium, you can reach the Fan Zone by going through Box2Box and out the other side through Gate 5. Supporters will also be able to access the club shop once entering the Fan Zone.

CASHLESS STADIUM



At St Andrews @ Knightley Park is a cashless stadium.

NO SMOKING



The stadium is smoke-free and smoking or the use of electronic cigarettes is not permitted inside the stadium.

WIFI



The Wi-Fi will be available and will appear as 'BCFC' on your mobile device. No password is needed.
