TICKET INFORMATION

WHERE TO SIT

Blocks E3, E4, E5 and E6 of the East Stand will be open for general admission with the West Stand offering a range of hospitality options. Block E7 is recommended for away fans to congregate together. Tickets can be purchased online at <https://itfcwomen.colchesterstadium.com/>. Supporters will need to register on the website. Home fans who are Super Blues members should make sure they use the same email address used to access the Ipswich Town ticketing website and their ITFC ID to claim a member's discount.

Note that there are no handrails in the stands, and the steps are very steep. We recommend that fans with mobility issues and with youngsters should sit towards the front. If you find problems with accessibility, please speak to a steward to see if you can be moved.

PRICING

East Stand (Full/Super Blues members)

- Adult - £11 /£9
- Over 65 - £9/£7
- Under 18 - £6/£4
- Under 11 - Free with a maximum of two free U11s per paying adult, then £3/£2 per U11

West Stand (Padded seat with access to the Layer Bar)

- Adults: £20

West Stand (Executive Suite with access to food and drink)

- Executive Suite (10 seats): £200 (Suite only)

TICKET INFORMATION CONTINUED

USING YOUR SEASON TICKET

All season tickets are digital for the 2026/27 campaign.

Ipswich Town Women season ticket holders can access their season tickets via the online dashboard on the ticketing website.

1. Go to: <https://itfcwomen.colchesterstadium.com/>
2. Log into your online account. The username will be the email you purchased the tickets with.
3. Once logged in you'll be at your dashboard and season tickets can be viewed or downloaded.
4. Supporters can also print these tickets off at home and scan them at the turnstile.

PURCHASING ON THE DAY

Alternatively, the Club shop at the JobServe Community Stadium will be open for supporters to book their tickets using a self-serve machine pictured on the right.



TRAVEL BY CAR – LONDON, SOUTH AND SOUTH-WEST

BY CAR

The Sat Nav postcode for the JobServe Community Stadium is CO4 5UP.

The stadium is located just off the A12, Junction 28 (Colchester).

The simple advice is to make your way to the M25 and join the A12 near Brentwood (Junction 28 of the M25). The A12 is a very busy road and is mostly a two-lane dual carriageway with no hard shoulder; accidents happen frequently, causing long delays.

Follow the A12 towards Colchester and Ipswich. Exit the A12 at Junction 28, turning right at the first roundabout. Go across the bridge and then go straight over the second roundabout, before turning right on to United Way from the third roundabout.

(If you are starting in the South-West, you have the option of driving via the Birmingham area (M42 to M6), though this is usually around an hour slower than the London / M25 route.)

We recommend allowing at least an hour and, ideally 90 minutes, beyond the AA / Google / Sat Nav suggested journey time, to allow for possible delays.

TRAVEL BY CAR – MIDLANDS AND NORTH

BY CAR

The Sat Nav postcode for the JobServe Community Stadium is CO4 5UP.

For supporters travelling from Sheffield, Nottingham and the North-East, make your way to the A1. Travel south on the A1 and join the A14. Continue onto the M11 towards London. At Junction 8, use the left two lanes to take the A120 exit to Stansted Airport/Colchester (note there is a stretch of just under 10 miles of non-dual carriageway from Braintree to Marks Tey). At the Marks Tey interchange join the A12 towards Colchester. Follow the A12 towards Colchester and Ipswich. Exit the A12 at Junction 28, turning right at the first roundabout. Go across the bridge and then go straight over the second roundabout, before turning right on to United Way from the third roundabout.

Note that from Sheffield, Nottingham and Leicester, there is the option of taking the M1 / A14 / M11 / A120.

A further option is to stay on the A14 past Cambridge to Ipswich, then join the A12 towards Colchester and London, following the directions below from Ipswich and East Anglia.

We recommend allowing at least an hour and, ideally 90 minutes, beyond the AA / Google / Sat Nav suggested journey time, to allow for possible delays.

TRAVEL BY CAR – IPSWICH AND EAST ANGLIA

BY CAR

The Sat Nav postcode for the JobServe Community Stadium is CO4 5UP.

Make your way to Ipswich. Join the A12 at the Copdock interchange with the A14, signposted Colchester and London.

To access the stadium, turn off at Junction 28, turning left at the first roundabout. Turn right on to United Way from the second roundabout.

TRAVEL BY TRAIN

BY TRAIN

The nearest station to the JobServe Community Stadium is Colchester.

For those travelling by train, the closest station is Colchester. Colchester is on the mainline between London and Norwich with a regular service to and from London and also to and from Ipswich. Some trains stop at Stratford for easy suburban rail, tube, Overground, DLR and bus connections .

Depending where you are travelling from there may be cross-country options available via Peterborough or Ely and Ipswich.

We would recommend allowing at least an extra hour for your journey to Colchester as delays can happen. There are ticket checks on all mainline trains, and barriers at London Liverpool Street and Colchester stations.

Note that there are often engineering works which affect the main line from London to Colchester, especially at weekends. We advise that you check before buying tickets.

Whatever your travel plans, it's worth checking <https://www.greateranglia.co.uk/> for updated times and any late changes to engineering works.

GETTING TO THE STADIUM FROM THE STATION

It is a 45-minute walk from the station to the stadium via Mile End Road, Nayland Road and Boxted Road,. It is possible to catch a bus which will get you to within a 10-minute walk of the stadium. Note that the Park and Ride bus does not operate on a Sunday. There is a taxi rank at Colchester station, but you would need to book a taxi back for after the game.

TRAVEL – TIER (E-BIKES)

Tier e-bikes

Tier are Europe's largest shared micro-mobility operator who provide sustainable ways to travel around Colchester. There is an e-bike hub located behind the South Stand at the JobServe Community Stadium. Providing e-bikes in Colchester as well as other locations in Essex, Dott offer convenient and sustainable solutions to get around without needing to drive, and it became the first climate-neutral company of its kind in 2020.

Geo-restrictions on United Way have been removed to allow supporters to ride right up to the turnstiles, with the e-bikes providing a great alternative to using a car.

PARKING

EVENT DAY PARKING*

On-site parking for around 700 cars is available at the stadium. This includes 32 spaces for blue badge holders.

Payment must be made using the RingGo app or website. You are advised to download the app in advance and follow the on-screen instructions to pay once parked. The RingGo location is 71667.

Tariffs:

Note that the advertised £7.50 matchday tariff does not apply to Women's games. Please pay for the number of hours you park for.

Convenience fee - 20p (we think this is compulsory)

STREET PARKING

There is very limited street parking around the stadium. If you choose to street park and walk to the stadium do check any restrictions and be respectful to the residents.

HOLLYWOOD BOWL

Parking can also be found at the Hollywood Bowl which is next to the stadium. Payment for the multi-storey car park can be made on the Parkonomy app or on their website at: <https://parkonomy.com/>. Search for Northern Gateway Leisure Park, CO4 5UP,. The location number is 1329. Staff will be available to assist.

PARK AND RIDE

Note that for ITFC Women games, the Park and Ride parking will operate in accordance with its normal opening times. It will not be open therefore for Sunday matches.

* Note there is currently reduced parking in the area adjacent to the South Stand. It is recommended that you park in the main car park area adjacent to the West Stand.

AROUND THE AREA

PUBS

There are no pubs close to the JobServe Community Stadium.

The Dog and Pheasant 24 Nayland Rd, Colchester CO4 5EG) is a 20-minute walk to the ground,

Colchester town centre has a large choice of pubs and restaurants.

HOTELS

The Travelodge Colchester Northern Gateway is next to the stadium.

FOOD AND DRINK

There are a number of food and drink outlets in the vicinity of the ground. These include a McDonalds (Stadium Junction, 28 A12, Colchester CO4 5HH) the other side of the A12, Wendy's (Unit 13, Northern Gateway Leisure Park, Cuckoo Farm Way, Colchester CO4 5UP), the Hollywood Bowl and Greggs.

Joyato a sushi restaurant, and Slim Chickens are both a short distance from the stadium.



OUTSIDE THE STADIUM



HERE2HELP

Our Here2Help staff will be positioned around the stadium on a matchday. They can be identified by their pink hi-vis and are pleased to answer any questions you may have.



CLUB SHOP / TICKET ENQUIRIES

The club shop is situated outside the West Stand. This will be open on matchday for any ticketing enquiries. Tickets can also be purchased using the machine in the club shop.



TURNSTILES

Turnstiles will open 75 minutes before kick-off.



LEGENDS BAR - CLOSED

Please note that the Legends Bar will be closed this season.



ENTERING THE STADIUM



SECURITY

Supporters may be searched prior to entering the JobServe Community Stadium. CCTV cameras are in operation around and in the stadium.



PROHIBITED ITEMS

The following articles must not be brought into the stadium- knives, illegal substances, fireworks, smoke canisters, air-horns, flares, weapons, dangerous or hazardous items, laser devices, bottles, glass vessels, cans, poles and any article that might be used as a weapon and/or compromise public safety. Any person in possession of such items will be refused entry to the ground.



BAGS

No bags larger than A4 will be permitted into the stadium.



FLAGS AND BANNERS

Supporters' flags or banners must be no larger than 2M x 1 M and/or of an offensive nature. These must be fire retardant and have an accompanying certificate which should be shown on the day. Home fans can use E2 to display flags, away fans should use E8. Please speak to a steward on the day.



MUSICAL INSTRUMENTS

Colchester United allow musical instruments. Please contact slo@itfc.co.uk before bringing an instrument.



PYROTECHNICS

As with all grounds and to comply with legislation, the use of pyrotechnics or even trying to get them into the stadium is a criminal offence.

MATCHDAY ACTIVITIES – SOUTH STAND CONCOURSE

FACEPAINTER

A face painter will be within the East Stand concourse at most weekend fixtures.

PLAYER SIGNINGS

At some matches, there will be player signings in the concourse prior to the game. For a 2pm kick-off these are likely to take place between 1pm and 1:30pm. This is subject to availability of players. Please look out for details on the Club website and social media in the days leading up to the game.

FAMILY FAN ZONE

You will also find the Family Fan Zone within the East Stand, with plenty of activities to keep youngsters entertained pre-match - including kid-friendly games and activities as well as EA Sports' FC video games.

BLUEY & CRAZEE

Our club mascots Bluey and Crazee will be in attendance for most fixtures where possible.

INSIDE THE STADIUM

CASHLESS STADIUM



The JobServe Community Stadium is a cashless venue. Payment can be made using a contactless card, Apple/Google Pay or the Colchester United Privilege Card. Full information on the Privilege Card can be found at this link: <https://www.cufc.com/fans/cashless-venue>

FOOD AND DRINK



Food and drink facilities are what you would expect at most football grounds. Alcohol will be available to purchase. Note that, unlike at the Martello Ground, alcoholic drinks cannot be taken into the stadium bowl. Catering facilities have low-level counters.

SMOKING POLICY



The JobServe Community Stadium is a no smoking stadium. This includes e- cigarettes. Anyone found smoking will be ejected from the ground.

TOILET FACILITIES



Toilet facilities can be found on the concourse. Sanitary products are provided free of charge. All wheelchair ganntries have designated toilets with specific facilities for fans with disabilities. There is a room with changing facilities in the West Stand.



RETAIL & MATCHDAY PROGRAMME

RETAIL

A small retail unit will operate in the East Stand concourse selling a range of items from our Planet Blue shop at Portman Road.

MATCHDAY PROGRAMME

A digital programme will be produced for the 2026-27 season. This can be downloaded from the Club website and saved as a pdf.



ACCESSIBILITY

PARKING

There are 32 accessible car parking spaces at the stadium. These are located in the main car park close to the Club shop and reception. Payment is made using the Ringo app – details are shown on the parking signs within the car park.

ACCESSIBLE ENTRANCE & FACILITIES

Accessible entrances are at turnstiles 9, 10 and 11 (E1 door) and turnstiles 12, 13 and 14 (E4 door). Please speak to a steward if you need assistance. They may be inside the turnstile so just ask. For those fans in the West Stand, access is through the main reception. Concessions have a low level counter for those wanting to purchase food and drinks.

ACCESSIBLE TOILETS

Accessible toilets are available in the concourse and on level 1 for those in the West Stand hospitality area. Toilets for those in wheelchairs are available in the dedicated wheelchair areas.

ASSISTANCE DOGS

Assistance dogs are admitted into the ground. Please purchase a seat in row A. Please contact Lee Smith on accessibility@itfc.co.uk or 01473 400556 for further information.
