Job Purpose

To be part of the stretcher party in attendance at WSL and EFL, U23, League Cup, FA Cup and 1st team friendly fixtures, to remove injured players by stretchers from the field of play, as directed by the Referee, Doctor, Paramedic or Physiotherapist.

Main Duties and Responsibilities

- To be a member of the pool of stretcher bearers being a team of 5 for each applicable match type.
- To liaise with medical and safety representatives including Team Physiotherapist, Doctor, Paramedic, Referee, Police, First Aid and Event Management
- To perform the instructions and rules as set out in the Stretcher Party Procedures and Emergency Medical Procedure.
- Be fit and active and can perform the manual handling requirements to lift and lower a stretcher.
- To attend a formal training class prior to carrying out stretcher party duties.
- Whilst on duty the stretcher party will wear a high visibility weatherproof medical jacket or bib provided by Reading FC. Members must wear appropriate layers of warm clothing beneath in times of cold temperatures.
- The stretcher party leader will instruct when the party can stand down by checking with the club doctor.
- The leader will be issued a 2-way radio as part of the Medical radio system. The call sign is STRETCHER PARTY and will address MEDIC CONTROL
- The referee may ask to see the leader prior to kick off to advise him of any special signals or rules he wishes to adopt.
- Able to speak clearly and have a good understanding of the English Language
- Able to work accurately in a high-pressure environment
- A strong team player with the ability to build and maintain positive relationships
- To adhere to a strict code of confidentiality in respect of any information relating to Reading Football Club and its operation
- To be presentable always when working and demonstrate that you can represent the face of the club in the manner expected
- To maintain Reading Football Club's Safeguarding (Child Protection), Health, Safety and Equal Opportunity procedures and practice
