GETTING TO ROOTS HALL.



Roots Hall has been the home to Southend United since 1955. Navigating your way to the stadium on a matchday is easy with various transport options to suit everyone. Located in Southend-on-Sea in Essex, Roots Hall is conveniently situated near the city centre, making it accessible by car, train, bus, on foot... and even by plane!

Address: Southend United Football Club, Roots Hall Stadium, Victoria Avenue, Southend-on-Sea, SS2 6NQ.

TRAIN

If you are travelling to the ground on a c2c service, the closest station will be either Southend Central or Westcliff, about a 50 minute train journey from London Fenchurch Street.

From Southend Central you can either walk to the stadium (approximately 25 minutes) or take the bus from Stop VS on Whitegate Road, on the opposite side of Southend High Street; buses normally run every five minutes, however timings may vary.

Alternatively, from Westcliff station, the walk is approximately 30 minutes.

Off-Peak c2c tickets purchased more than three days in advance of travel can benefit from a 40% discount - perfect for weekend fixtures. Children travel for £2 on c2c trains!*

*Up to four kids travel Off-Peak for £2 each with a fare-paying adult on weekends and school holidays.

CAR

For fans driving to Roots Hall Stadium, the ground is easily accessible from several major roads in the area.

From the M25

- If you're travelling from the London area or further north, take the M25 and exit at Junction 29 onto the A127 towards Southend-on-Sea.
- Follow the A127 for about 20 miles until you reach Victoria Avenue (A127) in Southend.
- Continue straight along Victoria Avenue, and you'll see Roots Hall on your right-hand side after about 1 mile.

From the A13

- If you're coming from the east (Canvey Island/Basildon) or west (London), you can also take the A13 towards Southend.
- When you reach Southend, join Queensway (A1160) and follow signs for the A127.
- Turn onto Victoria Avenue, and Roots Hall Stadium will be on your left after about a mile.

PLANE

The closest airport is London Southend Airport, located just a short distance from the ground roughly two miles away, making it an extremely convenient option for flying in to watch a game. The airport offers flights from a variety of UK and European destinations.

After landing, you can take a train from Southend Airport Station, located directly at the airport, to Prittlewell Station, which is just a five minute walk from Roots Hall.

Local buses, such as Arriva's Bus 9, run regularly from the airport into the town centre and stop near the stadium.

Taxis from Southend Airport to Roots Hall take around 10 minutes and can be found directly outside the airport terminal. The fare is approximately £10–£15 depending on traffic. The journey takes about 10–15 minutes.

GETTING TO ROOTS HALL.

Bus

Southend-on-Sea has a well-connected local bus network, making it easy to reach the stadium from the town centre, nearby areas, and further afield. There are several convenient routes that stop near to the ground which are the number 9, 20 and 29 served by Arriva and number 21/21A served by First Essex.

Buses may be busier on matchdays, so plan to arrive early. Be sure to check schedules and allow extra time for potential delays, especially during peak times.

PARKING.

Unfortunately, there is no matchday parking sold at Roots Hall except to season car park holders. There is limited street parking available around the stadium, but be aware of residents-only restrictions in some areas.

It's recommended to park further out from the stadium and walk to avoid congestion. Several pay-and-display car parks are located near Southend City Centre, which is a 10–15 minute walk from the stadium. These include:

Southend Council Car Park
University Square Car Park

Priory Park Car Park

Warrior Square Car Park

Short Street Car Park
Tylers Avenue Car Park

Traffic can be heavy around the stadium on matchdays, especially closer to kick-off. To avoid delays, plan to arrive at least an hour before the match starts.

TICKETS.



Tickets for home games go on sale at least three weeks in advance, and in some cases much earlier.

There are three ways to purchase tickets for our home matches. These are as follows:

ONLINE

The quickest and easiest way to secure your ticket for a game at Roots Hall is through our official ticketing website: southendunitedfc.ktckts.com.

Our online system provides a smooth experience, making it simple to purchase match tickets anytime, anywhere. When buying online, you'll receive a digital ticket that can be:

- * Downloaded as a PDF and saved to your phone, or
- * Added straight to your Apple Wallet for convenience.

On matchday, simply present your e-ticket at the turnstiles where it will be scanned by our operators. This means there's no need to visit the ticket office to collect your ticket before entering the stadium.

Fans will be required to register prior to purchasing tickets.

PHONE

You can also book your tickets by calling 03444 770077 during the Box Office Opening Hours which are:

Monday-Friday: 10am-4pm

Saturday (home matchday): 10am-kick-off

Sunday/away matchday: Closed

You can arrange a collection or have them emailed to you – whichever suits you best.

At busy times we urge supporters to book online where possible to avoid long wait times.

IN-PERSON


You can visit the BTMK Solicitors Box Office, located just off Victoria Avenue next to the Club Shop, to buy tickets during the opening hours:

Monday-Friday: 10am-4pm


Saturday (home matchday): 10am-kick-off

TICKETS.



It's cheaper to purchase tickets in advance. In-advance prices are available until midnight the day before the game. Subject to availability, tickets will be available to purchase on the day, either online or from within our main ticket office. Please note that we do not operate cash turnstiles.

We operate a QR Code entry system. Fans are not required to print tickets containing QR Codes as these can be scanned directly from a smart device. Where fans would prefer to print tickets, we ask that they ensure that the QR Code is clear and intact. Any incomplete or missing QR Codes will result in the ticket being unable to be used to gain access to the stadium.






Entering the Stadium

Access into Roots Hall for away supporters is via the main entrance, off of Victoria Avenue, through the fenced off route in the car park. The Fairfax Drive entrance is for **home** supporters only.

Away supporters are located in blocks NF, NE and ND in the Solopress North Bank. Turnstile operators will have handheld scanners which are used to give you access into the ground.





Security and Searches

Security and bag searches will take place at the turnstiles before entry, and you may be requested to open your own bag to allow it to be searched. Turnstile operators will conduct checks that the ticket purchased is of the correct age category.

Food & Drink

There is a small kiosk within the Solopress North Bank for away fans to purchase hot and cold food and beverages. This is currently not licenced to serve alcohol.

Matchday Programme

Our match programme 'The Shrimper' can be purchased from the Matchday Magazine hut located in the north-east corner of the ground, as well as from the dedicated programme sellers around the stadium entrances. Priced at £3, it's an essential matchday read, with all the latest news, exclusive interviews, stats and historical articles.

Disabled Supporters

Registered disabled supporters, upon confirmation of status, are entitled to purchase a concessionary ticket. Their carers (who must be responsible adults) will be provided with a complimentary ticket.

In line with league recommendations, confirmation of status requires evidence of a Disability Living Allowance at the high level of care.

Wheelchair bays are available in the away end, located under cover at the front of the stand. Easy-access seating is also available for ambulant disabled supporters. Disabled-access toilets are situated within the Solopress North Bank.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS



Can I park at Roots Hall?

Unfortunately, no parking is available at Roots Hall to supporters. There's some street parking available around the stadium, but be aware of residents-only restrictions in some areas.

What time do turnstiles open?

Turnstiles open 90 minutes prior to kick-off.

Can I pay for a ticket at the turnstile?

We do not operate cash at the turnstiles. Tickets must be bought online or from the BTMK Box Office.

What should I do if I lose/forget my ticket?

Contact the Box Office and they can arrange a duplicate ticket to send/collect.

Bringing awesome sights, thrills and frights to revellers of all ages, day and night, it's no wonder **Adventure Island** is Southend's number one free entry theme park!




