BOOKING TICKETS

Booking tickets is easy with our dedicated ticket site; **tickets.wwfc.com.**



Online

All fixtures that are available to book can be found on the main ticketing website. As a first time fan you are required to create an account before purchasing tickets by going to **tickets.wwfc.com** and clicking 'Create Account' (for mobile users, this is the icon with the silhouette+ symbol). You will then receive an email to the address provided; you'll need to click the link in this email to activate your account. After activating your account you can purchase your tickets.



In person

Tickets can be purchased from the club reception at Adams Park, Monday to Friday, 10am-4pm.


Tickets can also be purchased on matchdays at the Ticket Office however it is strongly advised to buy in advance.

STADIUM PLAN



Frank Adams Stand

The Frank Adams Stand is the most-booked area of the stadium, offering the best views of the pitch and Chiltern Hills, and comes with its own concourse area serving food and drink including draught beer. Please note there is no step-free access to the stand; there is lift access to the base of the stand, but has a set of steps leading to the seats.

Family Stand

Located on the lower south side of Adams Park, the Family Stand is an ideal area for younger supporters and their families, being close to the action, access to players for photos and autographs before and after the game, simple access from the turnstiles, two kiosks serving food and drink, and designated accessible areas. Tickets in this stand start at just £3 for under 11s.

The Terrace

The beating heart of the Adams Park atmosphere! The standing terrace accommodates 1,430 supporters behind the goal at the west end of the stadium. Supporters aged 12 and above can purchase a ticket for the terrace, due to height restrictions in this stand.

- -Easy access to the Chairboys Village, car park and food outlets
- Most vocal stand to cheer on the boys
- A great view of the goalmouth action!







Origin Stand

This stand has a choice of guaranteed seating and designated pitchside standing areas, with easy access to the bars. The Origin Stand is also close to the tunnel and dugouts, allowing you to get up close to the players and coaches!

- Pitchside and behind the dugouts
- Guaranteed seat but choice of standing in designated areas
- Easy access to the Chairboys Village and Caledonian Suite at half-time
- Closest stand to access points and car park

HOW TO FIND US



PARKING

Parking is only available at the ground if it is prebooked via **tickets.wwfc.com.**

The availability of upper tier car park passes may vary on a game-by-game basis and will be available at least a week ahead of the game, up until noon on the day before.

You can also park at Millbrook School on Mill End Road, walkable in under 20 minutes. Fans can pre-book spaces online before each home game at **tickets.wwfc.com**, or pay on arrival on a first-come-first-served basis if there is still availability. Gates open at 12 noon, and will be locked at 7pm, for a regular Saturday fixture.

Street parking is also available in the vicinity of the ground; however, supporters are warned that traffic wardens patrol the area regularly and we would ask you to park sensibly, respecting our neighbours in the Sands area.

Please note – after the game, cars in the upper and lower tiers will not be allowed to leave until Hillbottom Road is cleared of supporters.





ACCESSIBLE PARKING

Supporters with mobility issues can book parking directly with the club, with wide and standard spaces available on a first come, first served basis. These spaces are located behind the East Stand (Away End). Please contact the Wycombe Wanderers Ticket Office to book a space.

Parking in the lower tier closes at 12pm the day before the match.
