


From the M6 & M65 -Leave the M65 at Junction 7, taking the Clitheroe turn off the roundabout. Turn right at the first set of traffic lights following the A678. Follow the road to the next set of traffic lights. Turn right again towards Accrington on the A680. Carry straight on at the next set of lights with the Greyhound pub on your right. Take the first left after the Crown pub into Livingstone Road.


From the M66-At the end of the M66 follow the A56 until you come to the Rising Bridge roundabout. Take the first turning, the A680 towards Accrington for around 3 miles. Follow the ring road around the town centre. Opposite the Castle pub, turn right to rejoin the A680 following signs for Clitheroe and Clayton-Le-Moors. Drive up the hill under the railway bridge, through one set of lights and over a mini-roundabout. Livingstone Road is the next turning on the right.

Parking and Public Transport



Accrington is situated on the East Lancashire Line with direct trains to Preston, Blackpool North, Leeds and York, Rochdale and Manchester Victoria. The train station is a 20 minute walk to the Wham Stadium.

By Bus: From Accrington Bus Station, the number 7 bus leaves every 15 minutes to the stadium, taking approximately 5 minutes.

There is plenty of parking in the streets surrounding the stadium and no resident only parking, please park responsibly. Event Parking is available for a donation just 50 metres past the entrance to the stadium on Livingstone Road. (BB5 5BX)



Away Fans

There are 6 wheelchair spaces and an additional 6 assistant seats in Block H of the Studio.co.uk stand.

There is 'no step' access to any seat in Row A of the Studio.co.uk stand

This stand can be accessed through Gate 13 or through Turnstiles 13 or 14





There is disabled parking just 50 yards past the entrance to the stadium on Livingstone Road. Pay a donation to the local sports club on the day. It's only a two-minute walk to the away turnstiles



Away fans enter through turnstiles 13 and 14. There is disabled access at gate 13 adjacent.




Away tickets can be bought and/or collected at the away ticket booth next to gate 9, close to the away turnstiles.
