

SPRINGFIELD WEST STAND


For the TV camera view, take your seat in the Springfield West Stand. The tunnel side of The Brick Community Stadium is home to our exclusive hospitality facilities, TV gantry and to many of our longest-standing supporters.

FAMILY STAND (SOUTH)

Sit behind the goal in the South Stand to enjoy the match in our most family-oriented area at The Brick Community Stadium.

EAST STAND

Many of our most vocal supporters choose to watch matches from blocks ES2, ES3 and ES4. Home supporters wishing to bring along their flags will be allowed to place them in block ES1, which is a netted area. The East Stand is also home to the Family Zone (see section 13) and the Wigan Athletic Heritage Museum (see section 8).


CALISEN NORTH STAND

Supporters of visiting teams are situated in the Calisen North Stand.

In respect of selected fixtures (determined by the visiting attendance), Wigan Athletic offers a fantastic facility for visiting supporters; 'The Marquee'. This space ensures visiting fans enjoy their visit to the Stadium in style, with a free to enter facility underneath the North Stand. Up to 450 fans can be accommodated in this lounge, and entry is upon production of a valid away match ticket. Within this facility, hot food and beverages may be purchased, with licensed bars and a big screen television showing sporting events.

Visiting supporters are permitted to bring one drum into the stadium to enhance their matchday experience. However, prior notice must be given by emailing d.winnard@wiganathletic.com in advance of the fixture. Please note that the drum will be subject to a security search upon entry. The Club has a duty of care to all supporters, and any complaints or issues arising from the use of the drum may result in its removal, to be collected at the end of the game.

Flags without poles are permitted, provided they meet fire safety regulations; however, they must not cover sponsor banners, and supporters are asked to follow the instructions of stewards regarding their placement.



Each stand at The Brick Community Stadium has two designated accessible platforms in excellent positions with catering and designated toilet facilities available, lifts to each concourse and direct access to the platforms. These platforms are designated for supporters who use a wheelchair, with personal assistant seats allocated alongside the platforms. Additional wheelchair and disabled facilities are available at the front of the West Stand. A personal assistant, if needed, will be issued with a ticket at the Club's discretion on completion of a disability registration form. Please contact The Brick Community Stadium Ticket Office to obtain a disability registration form.

Match commentary facilities are available for visually impaired supporters in specific areas of The Brick Community Stadium. Headsets are available for a fully refundable deposit of £10. Please contact The Brick Community Stadium Ticket Office in advance to arrange collection of headsets.

The Club has a limited number of designated disabled parking spaces on Robin Park Arena, which may be purchased in advance by calling the ticket office via 01942 311 111. The area surrounding The Brick Community Stadium does not have any particularly steep gradients for disabled supporters to consider. We have designated space for two coaches with disabled supporters on board, which is 50m from The Brick Community Stadium perimeter. Any disabled coaches must prebook as early as possible.

Ear defenders are also available to hire for £10, which is fully refunded upon their return. These too are available from the Ticket Office.

DIRECTIONS & TRAVEL

HOW TO FIND THE BRICK COMMUNITY STADIUM



ROAD

The Stadium is located on Loire Drive, Wigan, approximately one kilometer from Wigan town centre. The Stadium is easily accessible from the M6 at Junction 25 for northbound traffic or Junction 27 for southbound vehicles. If travelling from the M61, take Junction 6 for Aspull and follow the signage to Wigan. The Stadium is signposted from all of these directions by the recognisable brown tourist information signs.

CAR PARKS

There are supporter parking facilities available around the Brick Community Stadium on a matchday, accessed by using Stadium Way using postcode WN5 0UN. Home supporters are advised to park in Car Park 3 or Car Park 4 which are priced at £7 for cars. Away supporters are advised to park in Car Park 1 which is priced at £7 for cars, £13 for minibuses and £24 for coaches. The Brick Community Stadium is a cashless venue and offers contactless card transactions in respect of car parking. Parking is available to pre-book for all supporters.

The Club strongly advises against parking on the adjacent retail park, nearby residential areas, or in any unauthorised parking space as it is likely that you will receive a penalty fine. The Club car parks are stewarded and are protected throughout the game. Wigan Council car parks at the front of the Stadium on Loire Drive must only be used if paying the applicable fee and displaying a ticket.

BUS

GMPT / South Lancs Travel operate a number of bus services (601-604) to and from Wigan Bus Station which has several stops on Robin Park Road, two minutes walk from the The Brick Community Stadium.

The 641 (Bee Network) now runs down Robin Park Road.

The 604 (from Wigan) and 603 (to Wigan) both Bee Network run near the cinema at the end Montrose Avenue, a 2 minute walk from the Brick Community Stadium.

Several buses from Wigan Town Centre pass through Newtown, which is a 5-10 minute to the Brick Community Stadium. These include:

TRAIN

The Stadium is well served by the local railway network. Wigan North Western is managed by Avanti West Coast and is an integral stop on the West Coast Mainline, offering journey times of just over two hours to London Euston, Glasgow Central and Edinburgh Waverley. Directly opposite, Wigan Wallgate is an important regional station offering services to Manchester and Liverpool, and various other north west towns. Both stations are approximately 15–20 minutes' walk from the Stadium, or an £8 taxi fare.

PLANE

Wigan is approximately 45 minutes from both Liverpool John Lennon and Manchester Airports, with easy access by train and motorway to both. Please note however, that there are no facilities for the storage of luggage within the confines of the Stadium.

CANAL

A famous section of the Leeds and Liverpool canal runs directly behind The Brick Community Stadium, giving you the opportunity to sail down to the stadium and moor up nearby. After the match, why not take the short trip to Wigan Pier!

Wigan Athletic advises fans and staff to travel on sustainable transport options where possible e.g public transport, active transport and carpooling etc.












LOCATION MAPS





















BEFORE THE GAME

THINGS TO DO AROUND THE BRICK COMMUNITY STADIUM



OUTSIDE THE STADIUM

The Brick Community Stadium was built on a large area of open land, which means that it is not overly crowded walking around the stadium on match days. Occasionally during the season, events will be held outside prior to matches. Check wiganathletic.com for the latest details.

SHOPS, RESTAURANTS AND PUBS

The Brick Community Stadium is positioned adjacent to Robin Retail Park. which is home to several large stores including Next, Boots, Smyths Toys and Pets at Home. Within Next is a Costa Coffee café, whilst Burger King, KFC, Greggs, Nando's and Subway are at the far side of the retail park. The Red Robin pub is approximately 500 yards from the Stadium and is welcoming to all supporters, but is used mainly by fans of the visiting club.

WHELAN'S SPORTS BAR

Located within The Brick Community Stadium, Whelan's Sports Bar is a modern and comfortable place for home supporters to enjoy live sports. Open on matchdays, the newly-refurbished bar has 50" 4K screens throughout with live sports available. Whelan's offers a range of beverages, alcoholic and soft. alongside a tasty menu including fresh wood-fired pizzas.

VISITING SUPPORTERS BAR

The Marquee ensures visiting fans enjoy their visit to the Stadium in style, with a free-to-enter facility underneath the Calisen North Stand. Up to 450 fans can be accommodated in this lounge, and entry is upon production of a valid away match ticket. Within this facility, hot food and beverages may be purchased, with licensed bars and a big screen television showing sporting events.

CATERING

There are mobile food vendors located around the perimeter of The Brick Community Stadium. Within the stadium concourses, there are Food & Beverage kiosks that serve a variety of hot and cold snacks and drinks. Cashless only.

TICKET OFFICE

If you have any gueries on the day of a game, the main ticket office is in the North West corner of the stadium.

INDOOR FAN ZONE

The Indoor Fan Zone, located in the South Stand, is home to the Official Wigan Athletic Supporters Club and opens three hours before kick-off. It is open to all Latics supporters, whether or not you are a Supporters Club member. All activities within the Fan Zone are organised by the Official Supporters Club team. Here's what you can expect inside:



- Pre-match interviews on stage with past and present players.
- Matchday Family Ouiz with prizes up for grabs.
- Raffle draws with fantastic prizes, including matchday hospitality and signed Latics merchandise.
- Tic 'n' Mix sweet stall.
- Pop-up Latics Shop at selected fixtures.
- 25% discount on food and drink for OWASC members until 90 minutes before kick-off.

LATICS STORE

Wigan Athletic operates its own official retail store located in the West Stand at The Brick Community Stadium. Latics Store is the only place where supporters can find the full and exclusive range of official Latics merchandise, including replica kits, training wear, accessories and a variety of fan favourites

Whether you're looking to proudly wear the latest home or away kit, pick up a gift for a fellow supporter, or add to your collection of Latics memorabilia, Latics Store is your go-to destination.

The Store is open from 10am to 5pm, Monday to Friday, and from 10am to 3pm on non-matchday Saturdays. On matchdays, Latics Store is usually open from 10am until kick off, then for 30 minutes after the full-time whistle. Opening hours on matchdays may vary, so supporters are encouraged to check www.wiganathletic.com for the latest information before visiting.

CASH MACHINES

The nearest cash machine is a five-minute walk away from The Brick Community Stadium It is located outside the Boots store on Robin Retail Park, and is marked on the adjacent map with a (2)

SAFETY NOTICES

The Brick Community Stadium is an all-seater Stadium. Above every turnstile, there are lists of items which are not permitted inside The Brick Community Stadium. Please note that it is an offence to have any of those items in your possession inside the Stadium. The Stadium staff and/or police may take action against you.

SAFEGUARDING

Wigan Athletic Football Club is committed to safeguarding those who are under the Club's care or utilising its facilities. Any safeguarding concerns should be reported to a steward or member of staff who will refer the matter to a member of our safeguarding team. Further details of the Club's safeguarding policy and contact information for the safeguarding team can be found on the safeguarding page on the Club website.

WIGAN ATHLETIC FAMILY ZONE

Young supporters from both home & away clubs can enjoy a vast array of prematch activities within our Family Zone. The Family Zone is located underneath the East Stand and can be accessed on the outer perimeter of the stadium. The Family Zone is open two hours prior to kick-off and is FREE for everyone to enjoy. Inside the main room, you can expect lots of fun activities, competitions and games, a visit from Crusty the Pie and sometimes first team players! There is a refreshment kiosk within the Family Zone too, which is a cash-only facility.

THE HERITAGE PROJECT MUSEUM

The Heritage Museum is operated by the Heritage Project volunteers. The museum entrance is located behind the East Stand and is open from 1pm on matchday for both home & visiting supporters. The volunteers will be displaying a range of artefacts, photos and programmes that date back to the year we were established in 1932. The volunteers also create an unofficial mini matchday programme that they sell for £2.00 inside the museum.

OUR FACILITIES

A NO SMOKING STADIUM

We are a no smoking venue. Smoking of cigarettes and e-cigarettes anywhere in the stadium is not permitted, however the Club has also introduced designated smoking enclosures that can be utilised by fans wishing to smoke or vape at half time. The pens can be accessed via the stairwells on each stand. For fans with accessibility needs, please speak to the nearest welfare steward (purple vests) who will be happy to assist you.

CONCOURSE CATERING

Once the turnstiles open, food and drink is available from kiosks throughout the concourses.

STEWARDS

If you have any questions or require assistance when you are inside the Stadium, speak with a Steward who will be happy to help you. We also have welfare stewards working within the stadium. These stewards are wearing purple high vis vests, and their role is to offer extra support to ensure everybody can access and enjoy the game.

BABY CHANGING FACILITIES

Baby changing facilities can be found in every concourse of the stadium for supporters in the stands, and also in the following locations in hospitality areas:
