<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Establish a GREEN COMMITTEE including a sustainability lead, a member of the senior leadership team, and a lead for each area - Productions, Operations and Buildings – and key staff members.	<i>Leadership is key but a senior team is needed to decide which Theatre Green Book level to target, make change, involve staff and report progress.</i>	<input type="checkbox"/>
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Agree an ACTION PLAN setting out the steps you need to reach the next Green Book stage, and a timescale to achieve it.	<i>You must be clear on the key actions needed to deliver measurable progress towards the environmental goal.</i>	<input type="checkbox"/>
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Make a DATA PLAN to set out what you are going to measure and who is responsible.	<i>You need to be in a position to report and analyse your progress, to achieve each Green Book standard.</i>	<input type="checkbox"/>
