COLLEGE BUILDING.

DURING the last year, the new and extensive College edifice in Crosby street has been completed. In its construction, no effort has been spared to provide within its walls every accommodation that may be necessary for carrying on the business of instruction in the various departments of Medical Science, and it is believed that in no one respect will it be found wanting in the great objects for which it was designed. To the planning of the Anatomical part of the building, especial attention has been

paid, with the view of furnishing every convenience and accommodation that may be required for teaching Anatomy, as well as for private dissection. In addition to the public dissecting room, a number of smaller rooms have been fitted up, where Anatomical investigations may be pursued in a more retired and private manner.

LECTURES.

The Lectures commence on the first Monday of November of each year and continue for four months.

The expense of attending a complete course of Lectures by all the Professors, is 108 dollars.

The matriculation fee, which is 5 dollars, entitles the student to the use of the College Library.

Students who have attended two courses are entitled after that to attend gratuitously.

GRADUATION.

Attendance upon two complete courses of Lectures (one of which must have been attended at this college,) is necessary to entitle the student to present himself for graduation. He must also have studied medicine three years, and attained the age of twenty-one years.

Two opportunities in each year are afforded for graduation; one on the first Tuesday in April, and one on the last Tuesday of October.

The examination of Candidates for the Spring graduation commences on the 1st of March, and for the Fall graduation on the 2d Tuesday in September. Graduation fee, 25 dollars.

NEW YORK HOSPITAL.

This Institution accommodates about two hundred and fifty patients, and presents every variety of disease and incident to which the human frame is liable. Situated in the very heart of

the city, and within a few minutes walk of the College, it possesses the great advantage of being easy of access, without any loss of time, and the students have daily opportunities of witnessing the practice of the house.
