The <u>Black Refugees</u> from the <u>War of 1812</u> were <u>African American</u> slaves who fought for the <u>British</u> and were relocated to Nova Scotia. The Black Refugees were the second group of <u>African Americans</u>, after the <u>Black Loyalists</u>, to defect to the British side and be relocated to Nova Scotia. However, there was also migration out of the colony because of the hardships immigrants faced. Reverend <u>Norman McLeod</u> led a large group of approximately 800 Scottish residents from the <u>St. Anns, Nova Scotia</u> to <u>Waipu, New Zealand</u>, during the 1850s.
