DECLARATION TO BE MADE AND SIGNED WHEN THE SOLDIER RECEIVES HIS DISCHARGE AT HIS OWN REQUEST.

I, James Daunt in the 86th Regt. of Foot
 hereby declare that I do, of my own free will, request to be discharged from Her Majesty's Service ;
 and I further declare, that a period of not less than Thirty Days has elapsed since I first made
 Application for my Discharge ; and it has been fully explained to me, and I perfectly understand
 that in receiving my Discharge at my own request, I entirely relinquish all Claim to Pension,
 and that, if I should re-enlist, my past Services prior to the Date of my present Discharge cannot
 be allowed to be reckoned for the purpose of obtaining any benefit from Chelsea Hospital, unless
 the re-enlistment shall take place within 12 Calendar Months from this Date, when one-half of my
 previous service will be allowed, nor unless I declare, on re-enlisting, the fact and actual cause of
 my present Discharge.
