

- 7 CONSIDINE. Erected by Anthony Considine/Liscannor to the memory of/his beloved father Thomas/Considine who dep^d life on/the 11th Feb^y 1850 aged 65/years.
- CURRAN. In memory of Catherine/Curran who died July 7th/18(3?)5 aged 64 years erect^d by her dear husband Patrick Curran.
- CURRY see CONSIDINE, 5.
- DEVIT. O Lord have mercy on/the soul of James Devit/who departed life 22/October 1883 ace (sic) 64 year^s/erected by his beloved/wife & sons Honora John & Michael Devit. (The decorations include 'tree-like' objects on either side of a chalice. A crowned standing figure faces the Cross with hands outstretched arms or hands, possibly the Blessed Virgin. Pincers, hammer and spear are also included - all crudely carved. One of the few of this type seen in the locality.)
- 1 DOHERTY. Two memorials, a) is a ledger slab with b) a headstone:
 a) Here lie the re/mains of John Doherty who de/parted life Nov^r 1835 erected by his/sons Mich^l Pat^k and Charles.
 b) Erected by/Bridget Doherty/Ballyvord/in memory/of her fond husband/Michael Doherty/died 20th June 1901 aged 50 years.
- 2 DOHERTY. Here lie the re/mains of Judith/Doherty al^s Ken/nedy who depart^t life Nov^r 1832 aged/63 yr^s erected/vy her sons John/Mich^l Pat^k & Char^l. (This memorial is adjacent to DOHERTY, 1, above, obviously the same family.)
- DOWNNEY. Erected/by Michael Downey in/Memory of his beloved/mother Margaret/Downey D.D. Nov 7th/1877 aged 58 years also/his sons Stephen &/John. (D.D., possibly abbreviation for deceased, etc.)
- EDWARDS see CAMPBELL.
- HEHIR. Erect^d by Will^m Lynes/in memory of his wife/Honora Hehir who/died 22^d March/1802 aged 55yr^s. (I think that this memorial should be listed under LYNES as Hehir appears to be the maiden name. A lengthy 'virtues' include the words 'a mother dear'.)
- HOLLAND. In memory of/Anne/the affectionate wife/of John Holland who/died at Liscannor 11th/January 1835 aged 35 yr^s.
- 1 KELLY. Erected by/Ellen Kelly of Lisheen/in memory of her/husband Thomas Kelly/who died 25th/July 1851 aged/50 years/also her son Pat Kelly/died March 5th 1883/aged 46 years.
- 2 KELLY. O Lord have mercy on the soul of/Thomas Kelly who/departed this life/February 11th 1841/aged 65 years.
- KENNEDY see DOHERTY, 2.
- KERIN. Two memorials, a) is a ledger slab and b) a headstone.
 a) This tomb was/erected by Mrs/Mary Kerin in memory of her husband Jeremi/ah Kerin who dep/arted 28 of/March 1816 aged 4(0) years.
 b) In loving memory/of/John Kerin/Lislarkin/who died 4th May 1917 aged 68/erected by his wife Catherine.
