- CURTIN. Erected by/Michael Curtin/Ballyfadeen in/memory of his fond/father Tim Curtin/who died 26th January/1873 aged 58 years/also his mother Mar<sup>y</sup> who died 23th(sic) July 1904aged 73 years.
- FLANAGAN. Erected by/Margaret Flanagan of/Moymore to the memory of/her beloved husband/John Flanagan who dep<sup>d</sup>/this life March 27th 1879/aged 65 years.
- FOLEY. In loving memory/of/Patrick Foley Carhuduff/who died 11th Feb 1863/also his wife Ellen/who died 16th Dec 1916.
- KELLY. Erected by/Thomas Kelly U.S. in/memory of his beloved/parents Edmond & Mary Kelly/the former died 11th August 1841/the latter died in July 1823/also in memory of his/departed friends.
- LARE. Pray for the/soul of Patrick Lare who dep<sup>t</sup>/<sub>dep</sub>/... March/1823 aged 19 yr<sup>s</sup>/erected bh his/brother Hugh Lare.
- McMAHON. Erected/by Laurence McMahon/in memory of his bel<sup>vd</sup>/Mary McMahon/alias O'Loughlin depd life/april 12th 1870 aged 33 years. (Mary - wife or mother? not transcribed.)
- MURRAY. In loving memory/of/James Murray Derry/who died 26th Oct/1856 aged 80 years/erected by his wife and family.
- MURRIHY. Here lies the body of/Honora Murrihy alias Walsh/who dep<sup>d</sup> this life in the/month of decr 1858 aged/60 years Erc<sup>d</sup> to her/memory by her loving/husband Thomas Murrihy.
- NEYLON. Erected by/Thomas Neylon Derry/in memory of his/father Martin Neylon/who died 24th March 1859.
- 1 O'LOUGHLIN see McMAHON.
- 2 O'LOUGHLIN. Erected by Colman O'Loughlin/in memory of his beloved son/Jim O'Loughlin/died 28th .... /1877 aged 35 years.
- RIEDY. In loving memory/of/Mary Riedy who died 28th Dec 1874 aged 52/also her children/Patrick Riedy/died 17th Oct 1883 aged 20/Bridget Riedy/died 1st Feb 1887 aged 22/Michael Riedy died 1st May 1897 aged 28/Erected by her daughter Kate Riedy.
- SHANNON. Monument with inscriptions on four sides:  
East. In memory of/James Shannon/Solicitor/Rivoli/who died on 8th November 1890.  
North. Also his/daughter/Juliana/who died on 25th/May 1879.  
West. In memory of/Mrs Juliana Shannon/and her five children/who died at Derry. (No dates)  
South. In memory of/Patrick John Shannon/Assistant Surgeon/
