

4 D'LOUGHLIN. Here lies the remains/of Honoria O'Loughlin/alias Doherty wife of/Cornelius O'Loughlin/of Caherkinalla/died 22nd of December 1878/aged 78 years/erected by her beloved/son Austin O'Loughlin/Philadelphia PENN. USA/in memory of his/affectionate mother/April 1887.

QUINN. May the Lord/have mercy on the/soul of Cornelius/Quinn who died/December 2. 1814/aged 64 years erect/by his son Thomas.

SHEEDY. Erect/by Tho/Sheedy. (A narrow undated stone, 19th cent. type of lettering.)

1 THYNN. Two memorials, ledger slabs, set into the west wall of the old church. The lettering, sem-Gothic in type, runs lengthways on memorials. They are either side of the doorway.

a) Here lies the body of Augustine Thynn who departed/ye year 1720 Mary O'Loughlin wife to hn (sic) Thynn the eldest/son of said Augustine Thynn dyed in the/year 1751 and two (sic) dated this 10 day ofan^ey 1752.

b) In Momento Mori/I was as you are and you will be as I am/this tomb was erected by Jeremiah/Thynn for himself and his/family Anno Dom 1717.

2 THYNN. Erect^d by August/one (sic) Thynne for/his son Henry/Thynn who died/Jan^y 3^d 1841/aged 20 yrs.
