

## KILSHANNY - OLD

The old graveyard of Kilshanny is situated approx. 1 mile to the east of Kilshanny R.C. church, the entrance is up a narrow lane from a side road. The R.C. church is on the Ennistymon/Lisdoonvarna road. There is carved on a hall door step of the Parochial House the outline of a slipper sole or instep, the parish priest could give me no information on its origin. One decorated headstone in the old graveyard was noted: to John HALAREY, q.v.

- BLOOD. Beneath/are deposited/the remains of Joseph Blood of (Fanlok?) who departed this/(earth)ly life on the/2d of Feby 1831 aged 30 yr.
- BRADY. Here lies the body of John/Brady who dep<sup>d</sup> this life Nov<sup>r</sup> 23/1831 ag<sup>d</sup> 52 y<sup>r</sup> also his bel<sup>vd</sup>/daughter Mary dep<sup>d</sup>/Feb<sup>y</sup> 27th 1847 ag<sup>d</sup> 32 y<sup>rs</sup>/Erd by his bel<sup>d</sup> wife Mary Brady.
- CALLANAN. Erected by/John Callanan/Slievenagry in/memory of his/father James died/15th May 1876 & his mother Margaret died aged 93 years. (No dates for latter)
- CROWE. John Crowe/born March 12 1791/died January 10 186(3 or 5).
- DOHERTY see O'LOUGHLIN, 4.
- DRONEY see O'CONNOR.
- HALAREY. Here lies the body/of John Halarey/who departed this life Sept 7th 1820/aged 68 years/erected by his/brother Joseph Halary ..... (Madigan, Ennistymon, cut this memorial, it includes a female figure in the attitude of prayer and of the usual symbols of the Passion, only the silver is shown.)
- HANRAHAN. Pray for the soul of/Austin Hanrahan/of Kilshanny/who died 11 Nov 1846/aged 70 years/and of his wife Margaret/who died Feb 12th 1873/aged 76 years/erected by their beloved son A.F. Hanrahan.
- HARTIGAN. Erected by John/Hartigan (in memory?) of his son/Pat<sup>k</sup> who departed/life Jan 1 1830 aged/27 y<sup>r</sup>.
- HEALY. Lord have mercy/on the soul of/Daniel Healy who departed this life/April 1822 aged 97/y<sup>r</sup> erected by his/son John Healy for/his own use.
- HOULAHAN. Here lies the/body of Michael/Houlahan who departed/this life the 2nd day of/December 1797/aged 57 years erected/by his son Michael/Houlahan.
