

Final Notice to Claimants and Incumbancers.

TAKE Notice that the Final Schedule of Incumbrances affecting the proceeds of the Sale of the Lands described in the Schedule hereto, which are situate in the Barony of Drumahaire, and the above County, and which have been sold under the Irish Land Act, 1903, in fee-simple, has been lodged in the Registrar's Office of this Court at 24 Upper Merrion Street, Dublin; and any person having any claim not therein inserted, or objecting thereto, either on account of the amount or the priority of any charge therein reported as due to him, or any other person or for any other reason, and particularly by reason of the following original title deeds not being forthcoming, viz.—Settlement of 3rd December, 1805, made between Phibbs White of the 1st part and John Phibbs William White of the 2nd part; Marriage Settlement, dated 25th April, 1829, made between John Phibbs William White of the 1st part, Jane Kildahl of the 2nd part; William Gardner and Vavasour Kildahl of the 3rd part, and Samuel Hamilton of the 4th part; and Settlement dated 18th May, 1833, made between Robert White of the 1st part, Adam Elliott and Ismina Elliott of the 2nd part, Alexander Burrowes and Thomas Irwine of the 3rd part, AND ALSO by reason of nothing being admitted to be due in respect of the following charges purported to be charged on said lands under said Settlement on the 3rd December, 1805, being Item 7 on said Final Schedule, viz—

- £400 in favour of Mary Anne White.
- £400 in favour of Elizabeth White.
- £400 in favour of Jane White.
- £400 in favour of Judith Anne White.
- £400 in favour of Robert White, and
- £400 in favour of any child or children of said Phibbs White and Dorathea White, born after the date of the said settlement.

And also by reason of nothing being admitted to be due in respect of the sum of £500 purported to be charged on said lands for younger children by said Settlement of the 18th May, 1833, made on the marriage of said Adam Elliott and Jemima Elliott being Item No 8 on said final Schedule, and also by reason of nothing being admitted to be due in respect of the following charges under the Will of Robert White, dated the 11th December, 1848, being Item No 9 on said Final Schedule, viz—£600 in favour of Robert White, £600 in favour of after born children of said Testator, and £2000, viz—£400 each to said Testator's daughters, namely—Dorothea White, Esmy Jane White, Mary Anne White, Eliza White, and Catherine White, is required to lodge an objection thereto, stating the particulars of his demand and duly verified, with the Registrar of this Court on or before the 12th day of December, 1913, and to appear on Thursday, the 18th day of December, 1913, at 11 o'clock, before

Justice Ross, at his Court, at the Four Courts, Dublin, when he will adjudicate upon the several claims appearing on such Schedule of Incumbrances and upon any objections lodged thereto. And Take Notice that any demand reported by such Schedule of Incumbrances is liable to be objected to within the time aforesaid. And further Take Notice that I have fixed Tuesday, the 16th day of December, 1913, at my chamber at the Four Courts, Inn's Quay, Dublin, at 11 o'clock in the forenoon, for the vouching of the several claims appearing on the said Schedule of Incumbrances, and all parties interested should attend before me on that day with the necessary proofs to vouch their respective claims with a view to the funds being distributed on the said 18th day of December, 1913.
