Occupation -Pit Sawyer

Residing in Ballinalee, Clonbroney, County of Longford when convicted of perjury in 1843, perjury related to fire arms in 1844.

Smithfield Prison January 1845

Transported to Tasmania, Australia on the ship Elizabeth and Henry -arrived 9 June 1845

Convict papers list mother Mary, sister Mary Ann and wife Bridget.

Certificate of Freedom- 2/08/1851

Died Hobart, Tasmania- 13 December 1892

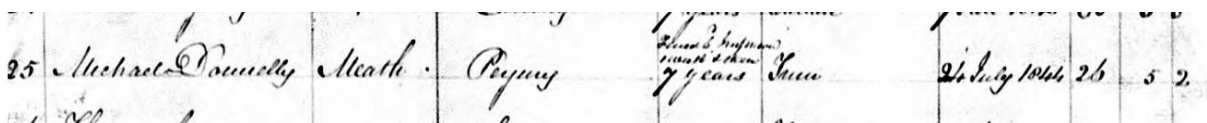

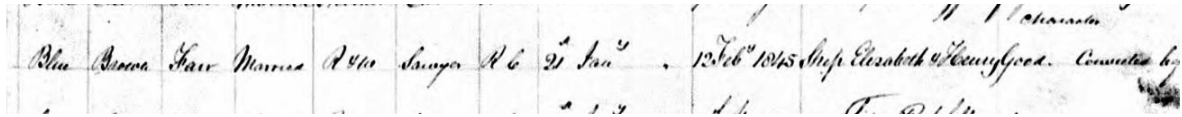

Transported for perjury, good report, convicted before, married, stated the offence-paying relatives to fire arms, denies any former convictions

Married, 2 children, can read a little

Surgeons report-good

Trade- Pit sawyer, height 5/1&half, 26 years, fresh complexion, oval head, brown hair, no whiskers, oval visage, brown eyebrows, blue eyes, medium nose, medium mouth, medium chin

Natural place Longford

Marks-pockpitted, scar on nose between eyebrows, scar across upper lip
