CHAPTER xcvi.

An Act to authorise the sale of Smithfield Penitentiary Convict Prison, Dublin. ABJ. 1876.
[13th July 1876.]

WHEREAS under and by virtue of an Act passed in the sixth and seventh years of the reign of His late Majesty King William the Fourth, chapter fifty-one, certain premises situate in the county of the city of Dublin, and formerly known as the Smithfield Penitentiary, were discontinued as a bridewell or prison for prisoners of or from the county of the city of Dublin, and the same premises became vested in the Commissioners of Public Works in Ireland by virtue of the warrant of the Lord Lieutenant of Ireland, in trust for the purposes mentioned in the fourth section of the said Act:

And whereas the said Smithfield Penitentiary premises have for some time past, ceased to be used or employed for any of the purposes provided by the said Act, and it is deemed expedient that they should be sold or otherwise disposed of as herein-after mentioned:

Be it therefore enacted by the Queen's most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and Commons, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1. This Act may be cited for all purposes as "The Smithfield Penitentiary, Dublin, Act, 1876."

2. The Smithfield Penitentiary and all the lands and tenements thereunto belonging shall be and the same are hereby vested absolutely in the Commissioners of Public Works in Ireland in trust to sell or demise the whole, or from time to time any part or parts thereof, to any person or persons or corporate body willing to purchase the same, or to take the same on lease for any purpose
