

Moose Jaw, & milestone in Sask, Calgary, Vancouver, Victoria, then Wallace, Idaho. visiting family members & seeking a new location for he & his family. By autumn of 1910, the Gaius Allen family was relocated in Calgary, Alberta.

In Calgary Gaius was a driver-conductor on the Calgary Transit System from 1912 to 1933. Then he was supervisor of the main picnic shelter at Calgary's Bowness Park. For picnickers teapots, hot dog pots, & baby bottles, he maintained & ladled out free-boiling water. He was an active Mason his wife Bertha a model "gentlewoman" & devout worker & member in Wesley United Church.

It is interesting to note that of 9 children this couple saw only 4 daughters grow up 4 sons, each died in their first year & Annie Grace, 9 yrs, died in a sleighing accident. The 4 are Maud, Clara, Mary & Beryl. Gaius, born June 26/1868 in Ont, died Dec 14/1953 at Calgary Alberta. Mary married James Gibson & their son Douglas Irving Gibson prepared this History.
