The Probation Board for Northern Ireland (PBNI) functions as a Non-Departmental Public Body, operating as part of the Department of Justice. Its primary responsibility is the assessment and supervision of offenders, both within correctional facilities and within the community. As a vital link between the criminal justice system and the wider society, the board plays a pivotal role in transforming lives, reducing crime, and promoting a safer and more secure environment for all.

PBNI provides supervision, support, and tailored intervention plans for offenders during custody and after release. They engage with offenders in the community, monitor progress, and offer behavioural change programs, vocational training, and education to reduce reoffending and promote successful reintegration.

CHALLENGES

PBNI grappled with several key challenges. These encompassed managing a growing caseload, handling extensive offender data, monitoring multiple cases, collaborating with other agencies, integrating with criminal justice IT systems like court databases and police records, generating managerial insight reports on case load statistics and outcomes, and safeguarding sensitive case data from unauthorized access and potential breaches.

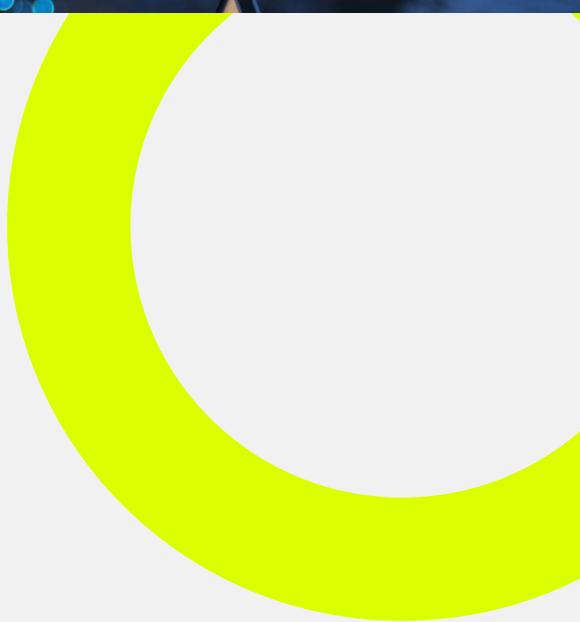
OUR SOLUTION
