Assignment Instructions and Certification Criteria

Assignment Instructions:

- Read the ASE Facilitator manual and Open Awareness handbook (provided to you upon enrolment).
- Write brief (point form) answers to each set of review questions that appear below all 44 training videos in one document.
- Below your 44 video reviews, in the same document, include a 150-200 word reflection on the importance of being trauma aware as a facilitator, including your key learnings from the Trauma Aware Resources for ASE Facilitators.
- At the end of the same document include a description of how you will apply the ASE Principles in your life (300 words max).
- Email us your assignment document with the above three assignments completed in it.
- Make at least one substantial post in the TCTN Forum.

Certification Criteria:

- Completion of the in-person ASE Facilitator training, all six days.
- Attendance of the six post-course group supervision sessions or listening to the recordings.
- Ability to demonstrate all core ASE Facilitator skills effectively.
- All assignments (from the above list) completed to an adequate standard.
- Signed IACATM Code of Ethics.

Please note:

Completion of these assignments and certification criteria is achievable in six months. If you need more time, after six months you will be required to pay the Supervision Group membership fee – for which you will obtain an additional year of monthly group supervision sessions, plus ‘fireside conversations’ with experts and access to all other professional resources for the Supervision Group members.
