Assignment Instructions:

- Read the ASE Facilitator manual and Open Awareness handbook (provided to you upon enrolment).
- Write brief (point form) answers to each set of review questions that appear below all <u>44 training videos</u> in one document.
- Below your 44 video reviews, in the same document, include a 150-200 word reflection on the importance of being trauma aware as a facilitator, including your key learnings from the <u>Trauma Aware Resources for ASE Facilitators</u>.
- At the end of the same document include a description of how you will apply the <u>ASE Principles</u> in your life (300 words max).
- Email us your assignment document with the above three assignments completed in it.
- Make at least one substantial post in the <u>TCTN Forum</u>.

Certification Criteria:

- Completion of the in-person ASE Facilitator training, all six days.
- Attendance of the six post-course group supervision sessions or listening to the recordings.
- Ability to demonstrate all core ASE Facilitator skills effectively.
- All assignments (from the above list) completed to an adequate standard.
- Signed IACTM Code of Ethics.

Please note:

Completion of these assignments and certification criteria is achievable in six months. If you need more time, after six months you will be required to pay the <u>Supervision Group membership fee</u> – for which you will obtain an additional year of monthly group supervision sessions, plus 'fireside conversations' with experts and access to all other professional resources for the Supervision Group members.
