

Maths

In Maths this week we have begun to look at division. We have modelled it as **sharing** and as **grouping**. We can draw the groups as arrays and are beginning to make links to multiplication.

Mrs Dollin was baking cakes for Mad March. She can fit 5 cakes in her oven. In total, she made 75 cakes. How many batches of cakes does she need to bake?

$75 \div 5 = 15$ groups

She needs to bake 15 groups altogether.
